It delivers live GPS tracking, geofencing, and event-based reporting to give managers a clear, accurate picture of what's happening across farms, fields, routes, and bunks—without relying on guesswork or manual logs. **This presentation will highlight practical use cases in dairy and manure management, including bunk management, chopper and truck tracking, load verification, and time-on-task visibility. Guest speakers will discuss how Track Tracker improves feed delivery accuracy, reduces missed or duplicated work, and provides reliable data on equipment movement, task duration, and key operational events.**
