



General Liability Insurance Required of Vendors in Country (e.g. NGOs, tour guides, lodging)

General liability insurance protects against liability other than that arising from vehicles.

The University's **standard requirement for vendors for general liability insurance is USD \$1 million**. We understand, however, that insurance availability and policy limits vary significantly across countries. To support departments working with international vendors, we have provided a reference chart outlining alternative minimum requirements for specific countries where standard limits may not be available. Please note that outside the U.S. General Liability insurance is often referred to as Public or Civil Liability insurance.

The following standard limits for small to medium businesses apply in the destination country and should be requested. **If the country you are engaging a vendor in is not listed below, general liability insurance is still required - contact Risk Management** to determine the insurance requirement for that location.
