## **Molly Bog: Bibliography**

### Natural Areas Archival Collection

*University of Vermont*

This list represents research relating to the University of Vermont's Molly Bog Natural Area. Part of 11 total Areas, the bog complex has been in the University's possession since 1962. As a perfect example of a northeastern kettle bog, it is home to several endangered species, such as southern twayblade and hidden-fruited bladderwort. The main goal represented in the collection is the prevention of damage constantly threatened from logging and farming near the site.

The documents listed below are those which pertain to research undertaken in the Area. The documents are sorted by the location at which they can be accessed or found.
