For those of you who have worked with us in the past, a few recent changes that will continue for 2026:

- The course will continue in the 2-loop format we've had the past few years.
- We will continue to have first responders stationed throughout the course at aid stations, and centralized advanced patient care at the Waterfront.
- Returning credentialed medical volunteers will continue to be able to request their location/assignment at signup. Just as was the case last year, we may not be able to honor all requests, but we will certainly take them into consideration, along with the other factors we have always used to determine assignments- area of expertise, composition of the volunteer pool, previous experience with us, etc.
- Volunteer duties will start early on Sunday morning, and you can expect to stay through the middle of the afternoon, depending on where you are stationed. If you have time constraints, please let us know when you sign up or ASAP, as that may affect where we place you.

There will be an orientation meeting held for new volunteers via Zoom in mid-May, we will provide additional details on this in the next few weeks.
