



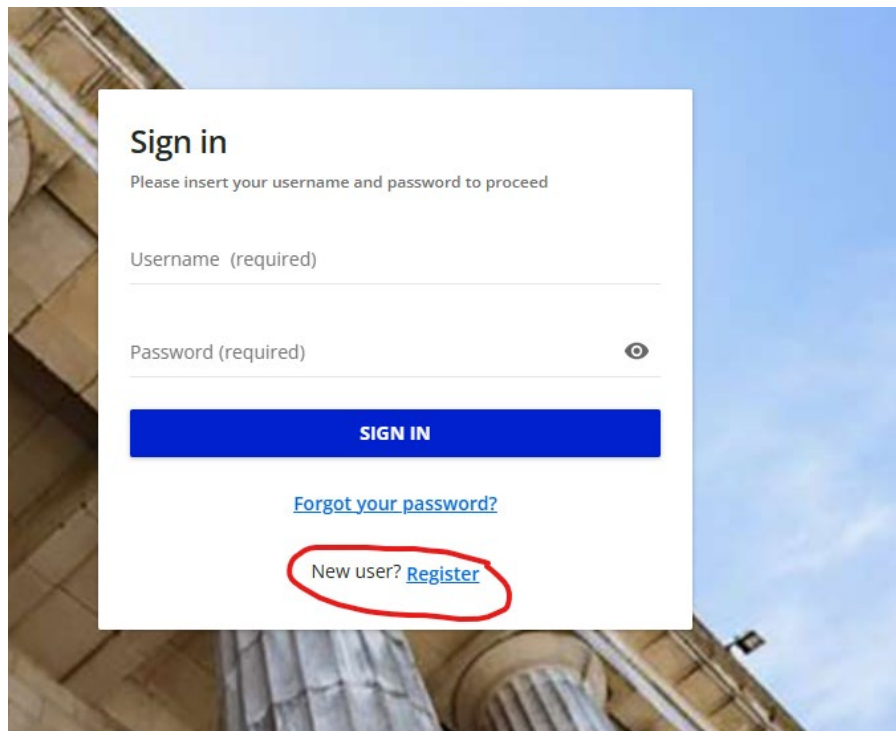
PROTECTING MINORS TRAINING INSTRUCTIONS

The University of Vermont's Protection of Minors Policy requires that all individuals who will have care, custody or control over *unaccompanied or unchaperoned* minors participating in UVM-sponsored programs on campus complete free, on-line training through United Educators prior to their participation in the UVM-sponsored program involving minors. This training is one-time and does *not* need to be updated or repeated once completed.

Program Sponsors are responsible for ensuring that the Protecting Minors training is completed by all individuals who will have care, custody or control over unaccompanied minors prior to the UVM-sponsored event, as well as maintaining documentation of completion of the training.
