SUMMARY OF PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES- OVERALL

I have been the director of the pediatric pulmonology and cystic fibrosis programs at the University of Vermont Children's Hospital since 2001. My primary role had been to provide direct patient care as the sole practicing pediatric pulmonologist in the state for 12 years. Over the past 10 years, I have overseen the growth of our division to include 5 pediatric pulmonologists including a pediatric pulmonary sleep specialist.

I have served as a clinical attending in pediatric pulmonology and pediatric intensive care since 2001. In 2015, I was appointed Vice Chair for the Department of Pediatrics at the University of Vermont. During my time as Vice Chair, I led the recruitment of 49 new pediatric faculty members. I have served as the Cystic Fibrosis (CF) Center Director and CF Pediatric Program director since my arrival. Our CF program has achieved excellent outcomes and has received a Quality Care Award at the time of our last three accreditations. We have achieved excellent upper quartile rankings for primary clinical outcome measures, with most recent metrics revealing that our nutritional and pulmonary indices are the best in the nation. I have personally been recognized with our pediatric resident teaching award on several occasions. Our pulmonology program was recognized as a Best Children's Hospital by U.S. News & World Report for 2012-13. Multidisciplinary programs were developed in 2013 for infants and children with aerodigestive disorders, and, in 2014 for children with tracheostomies and dependence on chronic home non-invasive or invasive ventilation needs.

SUMMARY OF TEACHING ACTIVITIES

My teaching responsibilities have included medical student, resident and fellow education. I have provided annual lectures in preclinical medical student courses, including an annual lecture on their “first patient.” Until 2013, I was solely responsible for all didactic sessions involving pediatric respiratory disorders. To better prepare our pediatric residents for their board exams, I began to hold weekly, interactive 30 minute sessions to focus on content as well as practice questions from prior years. I have received the Pediatric Resident Teaching Award three times and have been nominated on numerous other occasions. I was awarded the UVM Medical Center Graduate Medical Education Teacher of the Year in 2014.
