Vermont AIM brings the Urgent Maternal Warning Signs patient education initiative.

To meet the learning and language needs of birthing Vermonters, VT AIM utilized the ACOG Urgent Maternal Warnings Signs patient handout to create a video explaining these warning signs.

A collaboration with the Vermont Language Justice Project, brought these videos to life and worked with local people to translate these into 21 different languages including American Sign Language.
