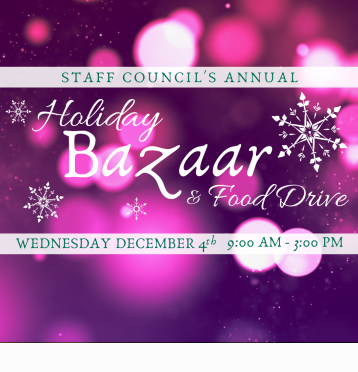
## STAFF COUNCIL NEWS

Dear UVM community,

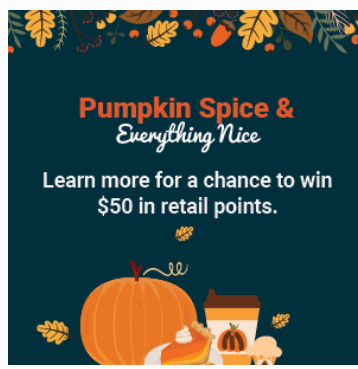

Each clinic offers the flu vaccine, and you can select a covid vaccine in the sing-up process. It is safe to get both at one clinic. The 2024-25 Covid-19 vaccine is recommended for everyone 6 months and older this season. The pharmacist will give anyone 65 and older the appropriate flu vaccine recommended by the CDC. Also available is an egg free vaccine option, the patient must let the pharmacist know they prefer this vaccine at the clinic.  
All cancellation and reschedule of appointments will be done directly with Kinney Drugs though the email received at the time of booking.
