(E) Fern found on ledge below: prob.  
Woodria ilvensis. Viola  
sororia, not CUC., reported, not obs.

(D) Chimaphila  
Umbellata

(H) Epigaea +  
Gaultheria proc.

+ Woods mixed with white  
pitch pines, HEM, OAK.  
Beneath MC, TB, AN,  
as in Del. Co. aban.  
pastures.

(B) 1 fir on wet terrace.  
+ 3 above the ledge.


(K) foundation stone corner  
possibly a garage or stable?

(I) Fir sapling off trail, but  
visible.

(G) Man-made mineral island, not a  
floating mat.

(F) The 3 west islands have shrunk from the  
1990s, but the eastmost one is still  
large with leatherleaf


(J) Viola macloskeyi in flower trailside, ssp.  
pallens. Sam Adams found this day before on  
Diamond Notch trail. Upper petals reflexed & twisted.  
LVS crenate & glabrous
