Near top of ridge, at (A), PB seed source is more abundant & PB dominates the opening. Some BC + MD pioneering in the opening.

Below, PB seed source is less abundant & openings are pioneered by RA, RS, DP & PCII, around (B).

There is some SVB along ridgecrest, maybe 25%, at (C) plus \$INT + \$CAMPL + OX.



\$ The two spp. vary in shade tolerance, \$INT more so. 50' crown on ridge at (C). Saplings & sprouts date the logging ca. 2000.

\$ CAMPL turns brown & drops off first in canopy gaps, those in some shade stay green longer.

PCII climbs up RA!

YB's can grow 2 to 2½ ft/year in the open. Allow for this in estimating ages of trees from ring counts of fallen broken limbs high up. ✓ recorded



BC sprouts 12' tall and 5 or 6 y old.


Allow for rapid height growth in BC, too. ✓ recorded


