# Kelly Hollow notes

from 1/2/19 Long Loop hike with Alan VTA  
to show the barn + farmhouse foundations.

- ① Look at Bear's Ulster Co. Atlas for Hardenbergh School is EAST of road heading up to Ward & Kelly farms, not WEST. No wonder an earlier search for the school foundation in the Jack pine was fruitless.
- ② Walk along the EAST side of the Ward & Kelly Farm Norway spruce plantations looking for Corbett & Stuart log roads that might ascend the long north spur of MBR. Follow them up to where they may end at cliff bottoms and get more entry points.
- ③ Three spp of Lycopodium emerged above 1/2" of snow on the "nose" of the spur between the E & W forks of the Kelly Hollow stream: about midway between the Kelly Farm & the lean-to. Much ASH in here following ca. 1914 Corbett Stuart: LL, Lco obs., Lcomplanatum.

④ Alan read the journal inside the lean-to. Campers reported beaver activity in June & July 2018 rebuilding the dam. Pond nearly full on 1/2/19. Last MK visit, with John Thompson, was in Sept. 2016 when pond was smallest water level at the CCC dam. Yet, on W side of pond on 1/2/19, older LM saplings cut, by beavers showed 3 years of growth: 2016, 2017, 2018. If cut in 2015, why was there no pond in 2016? Dam never completed?

- ⑤ Small outbuilding foundation along E side of W trail must be Andrew's, plus stone walls.

of RM, BC dom, only a few ASH. NTF,  
Lycobis & DP. Terraced slopes  
none steep, B+QST understorey, few  
HEM.

along with MKNHP + Van Loon Hill for  
abun - pastures but prob. no burns.


Mitch locally in flower in dense nor.  
Few spruce saplings just below Ⓐ

- Ⓑ 11:00 gap  
Ⓒ Cove with SVB, LAP, IMP, CAUL, PA, seeps  
11:15 descend into cove then reascend  
Ⓓ 11:40 road  
Ⓔ big BC complex blowdown + seeps 11:50  
Ⓕ 2nd cove, one will eroded a channel  
1 ft deep into till  
Ⓖ 90° bend in brook NOON (12:00)  
elev. 2160  
Ⓗ bridge on trail 12:10  
Ⓘ Lunch break at Kelly Farm 12:30  
Ⓣ Wall cusp 12:40

How to best reach the old (Corbett +  
Stewart? or Kelly Farm?) road:

- ① Hike east from trail at bridge (H),  
following N side of brook about 0.2 mile  
until it bends abruptly to S upstream (G)  
② Continue straight ahead east  
over 2 seeps until plantation ends (O).  
Pass dunned BC complex to north (E)  
③ Turn N (left) at upper end of planta-  
tion (Z) + follow the limit until it  
crosses the road at (D), about 0.2 mile.  
If this is only a farm road, it may  
soon end. Road is blocked by the big  
dunned BC complex + a dense LAP-IMP  
seep at (E).

- Ⓚ end hike, ca. 12:50  
Ⓛ wall 1:10  
Ⓜ wall 1:15  
Ⓝ 1:15  
Ⓗ snack time 1:22 to 1:33 el. 2111'  
Ⓝ wall along trail along steep pitch 1:37  
Ⓞ Ward farmhouse 1:41 el. 2010  
Ⓟ short loop June 1:48 el. 1958'  
Ⓡ Garrett Farm walls beam 1:53 rel. 1840'  
Ⓡ Trailhead 1:59, elev. 1774'
