**SUBJECT:** Land Use Inventory Reports

**TO:** All NWR's in NEA

On August 4, 1981, ARW circulated a memorandum to have acreages reported by Refuges to be congruent with those reported in the Annual Realty Report (ARR). A significant improvement resulted; however, further compliance and improvement are needed.

This means that some Land Type Inventory Reports must still be corrected, or initiated, and submitted to the Central Office Refuge Management Information System (RMIS). These stations are listed on the attachment, with acreages reported by ARR and RMIS plus discrepancies and comments. Initial and corrected reports for each station should reflect on line code 0400000HZ (TOTAL REFUGE ACRES), the same acreage as shown in the ARR column on the attachment. Detailed land classification acreages should total to this same figure.

The total acreage for a few stations may change prior to October 1, 1982. ARW will contact these stations between October 1-5, informing them of any changes. These stations can then submit updated reports to RMIS, in time to be included in the '82 printouts.

As the John Hay property is a life estate and not yet a part of the Refuge System, its acreage should not be reported to RMIS. RMIS will be requested by the RO to delete the John Hay acreage from its file.
