

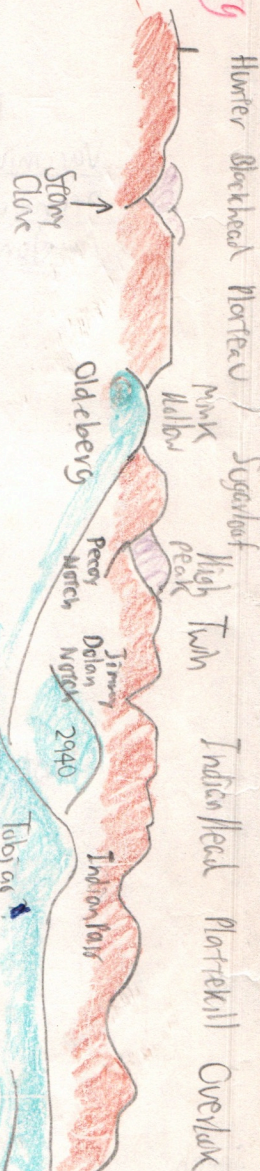

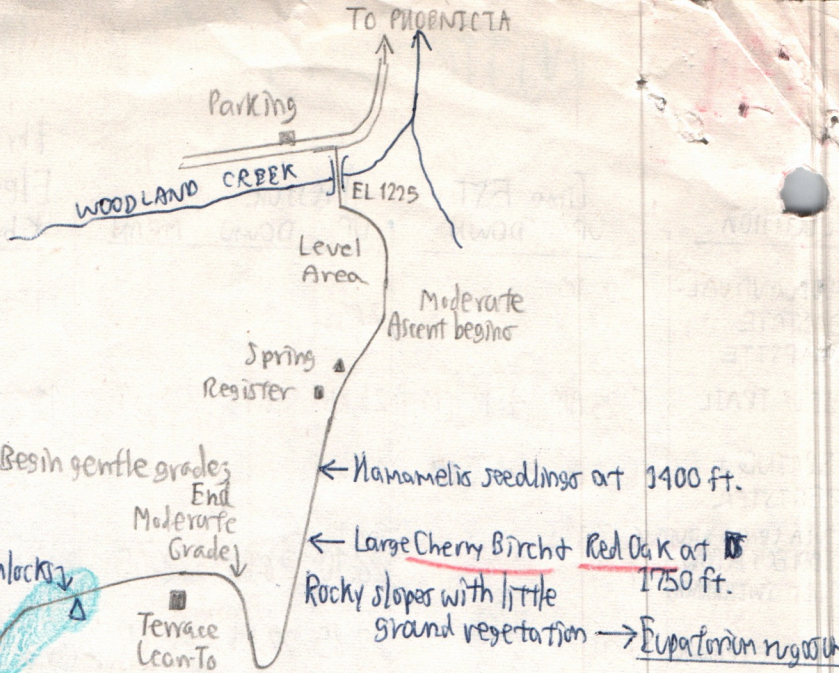

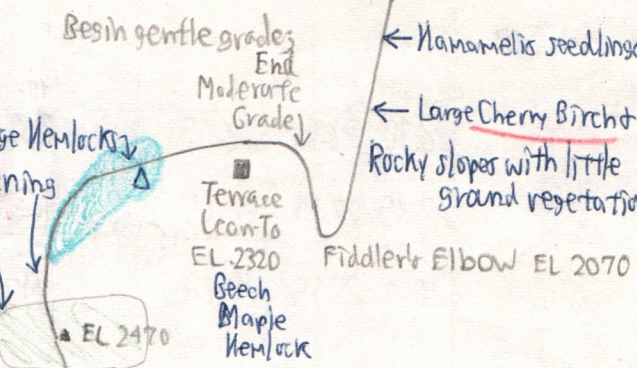
Begin gentle grade; End Moderate Grade

Amelanchier Bartramiana, Sorbus



Second open conglomerate area

End Gentle Grade, Begin Steep grade EL 2950

First Fir spruce; also Paper birch + Mtn Ash

Rhododendron, Ilex montana

View of Slide → Spring 3750

Virgin Spruce - trees of all ages, up to 30" DBH + 80' tall. Few Fir birch.

First Plateau 3240; difficult ascent.

Cornell Summit 3860 Spruce-Fir

Successive Plateau difficult ascent

- Vaccinium
- Abies 8" DBH, 15' tall
- Derchampsia, Maianthemum
- Aralia, Cornus, Sorbus,
- Betula papy, Nemophanthus
- Prunus pennsylvanica
