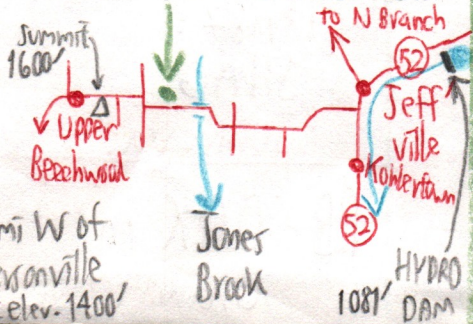

6/2/87: Willow collected along Emory-Vly Brook Confluence at Valkyrian Motel with fruit = S. fragilis

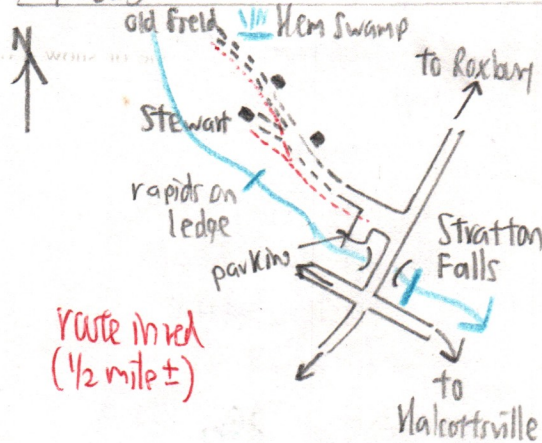
Malcolm Brown (Jeffersonville Hydro) reports: American Chestnut fruiting 10/86, an isolated sprout 8 to 10" DBH:

- ① along Shandeele Rd below (E of) Shandeele Lake betw road & beaver meadow, SW of Livingston Manor
 - ② at Jeffersonville Hydro
- Azalea in flower along Beech Hill Rd, S of divide, in fields, ± 2000' elev on return trip.

Lake Jefferson = 1081' elev on E Br Callicoon Cr. SS ledge below dam, S side only. Dam is 21.5' high (head to tail) ASH, OST, BC, YB, CUC, EARP, CRAT, HEM, VV, arboreal willows, RHODO MAX. under hem along creek. Dam at Tannery site.
