Geology:

Ledge exposed at (E) but
 inaccessible from trail end unless
 one wants to walk in mud seeps.
 Gray SS & SH.

Tills: all SS & SH, NO limestone
 breccia boulders seen at all
 in the Park.

At Falls:

Map at (A) has gray SS & SH ledge
 shaded in brown (A)
 with 2 photos of narrow
 gorge. NO LS breccia.
 Area shaded yellow (B)
 is deeply-dissected
 drift, almost moraine-like
 with knobs & steep
 ravines.

Stump at (D) >30 years
 probably the last logging
 before this State Park
 was established in 1973.
