False Kellebore wet flat

PROB-NOT, 6 ft high hill might have been used as head of cable railway. It does not look natural & needs excavation.

Conclusions: Mulholland says that the cable RR's head (i.e. top) was at Lumber Camp. Regina suggested that the cable followed the path of least resistance down the 3 ledges (i.e. along the trail) and the remnant fragments of cable, pipe & sheet metal confirm this.

Many 2" diameter pipes.

Open Lumber Camp area

0.25 mile according to Mulholland from Escarpment Trail Jc. to Lumber Camp

Upper ledge

Ledge #6

middle ledge: trail seems graded through it with cut + fill obliquely

False Kelle box wet flat

No cable RR evidence in this area; it must have changed direction with the trail.

Lower ledge

wet area

possible old grade (needs careful checking)

to Mary's Glen Trail Junction with yellow Rock Shelter trail (0.75 mile according to Mulholland) from Escarpment Trail Junc.

Escarpment Trail to North Point (Blue)
0.0 mile

Ledge (1st to North Point)

Ledge #7

Escarpment Trail to Badman Cave Trail Jc. (Blue)

Upper terminal sand 4/8/10

1st Red pipe + Fir

Albany Point = Spruce abun. but fir rare

6 ft high hill might have been used as head of cable railway. It does not look natural + needs excavation.

pipe vertical

Mulholland's Rock Shelter

cable midway down ledge in pieces

Cable + pipe

Ledge #5

metal sheet, 2" wide, about 4' long exposed at ledge base

Cable RR should be straight

Ledge #4

pipe fragments not relocated in 2010
