- (A) CARP ASH along Faulkner Rd. 2090'
- (B) (see map) 2254'
- (C) farm road turns west along fence row between 2 fields. 2318'
- (D) 30" SUGS along high stone walls. Old field now SUG&RM to 8". Fields aban. 1940s? ASH-OST. 2510'
- (E) Road jogs W, then N, in open field. 2592'
- (F) End of fields & base of 1st high ledge. Trailer Camp owned by the Parkers. 2710'

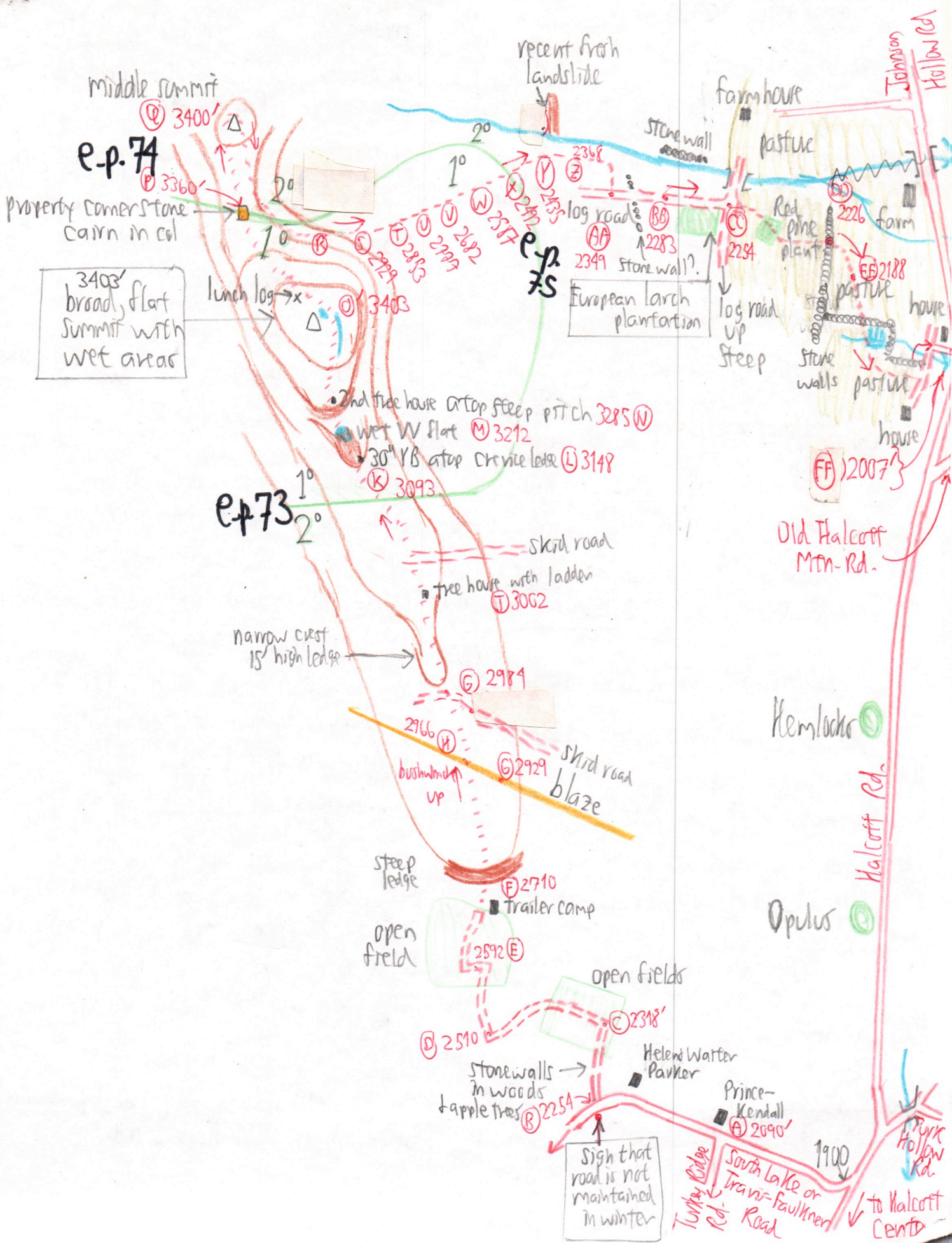
Top of high ledge: 1 OAK, last several ASH, Carex penni?

- G Parkers (?) property line climbs onto E side of ridge. 2929'
- H Property line crosses the ridge crest. Stumps ±25 years. 2966'
- I Skid road climbs up onto the ridge from the SSE (RA abun.) at the base of a 15' ledge forming a narrow crest. 2984' Stumps with bark still on, ±10 years.
- J Tree perch with ladder. Cross 2nd skid road which climbs up onto the ridge from the east. SUG-BC-MO-CMC-ALLIUM, but NO ASH. 3002'
- K 1st Growth. BC dom to 24", SUGs to 24", Canopy 60', \$, OX, MC, ERY, VV, TE in fl. NO stumps NO roads. 3093'
- L 30" YB atop chance ledge. 3148'
- M VV wet flat. Thalic, Vpap, TIAR, Dentaria diphylla, Anemone in fl. ^{3/2}
- N 2nd tree house atop steep pitch. RA abun, but NO logging, because of open stand. SUG 24", YB 24" & 28" 3285'

Summit Flora, 3403'.
 Trees AWAY from the wet spots are 40 to 45' tall. YBs to 28", several SUG to 12". BCs 20" to 22" to 30". B, MO, RM, VA. About ten large AMELS in full flower. CLAY in fl, ERY, AA, \$, TE, OX, UVUL, MC

- O Summit wet spots-- not too boggy & not too much Sphagnum. Spiraea both spp., VB, Chelone, CIMN. This stunted to 25' or 30' surrounding the wet spots. Red shale.
- P Col 3360'. Stone property corner cairn.
- Q To N of cairn, stumps with bark off, & on, not black. 20 to 30 years. CB
- R Middle summit. 3400'
- R Leave col & begin descent 33" YB, SUGs from 20" to 33". Extensive VA ^{thicket} stand
- S Species same, but none > 24" 2929'
- T SUGs seedling = European or native? 2853'. NO SUGs trees observed all day.
- U BASS, SUGs & YBs to 24". 2779'
- V KAMAM, MM, 36" SUG. 2682'
- W² 36" SUGs, ASH seedlings. → 1 live, 1 down. 36" YB. 2587'
- X ASH. 2° begins. 2492'
- Y Fresh landslide obs across the valley into the stream. Anemone. 2435' [Stream at ca. 2385'] ^{about 50' below}
- Z 1st stump on descent. Ost. ASH logs. 2368'
- AA Bushwhack UP to log road. 2349'. Stonewall (orientation not recorded)
- BB 2283'. Stonewall follows brook on N.
- CC Euc. larch plantation on S. Gentle slope down to 2254'. Steep new log road climbs up to S.
- DD Pasture across brook to N. Red pine plantation.
- EE Stonewall crossed. Apple. Enter large pasture 2188.
- FF Arrive on public highway at 2007'. 2 Kemlocks (1st seen all day) & Opulw along highway N of Twk Nollaw Rd.
