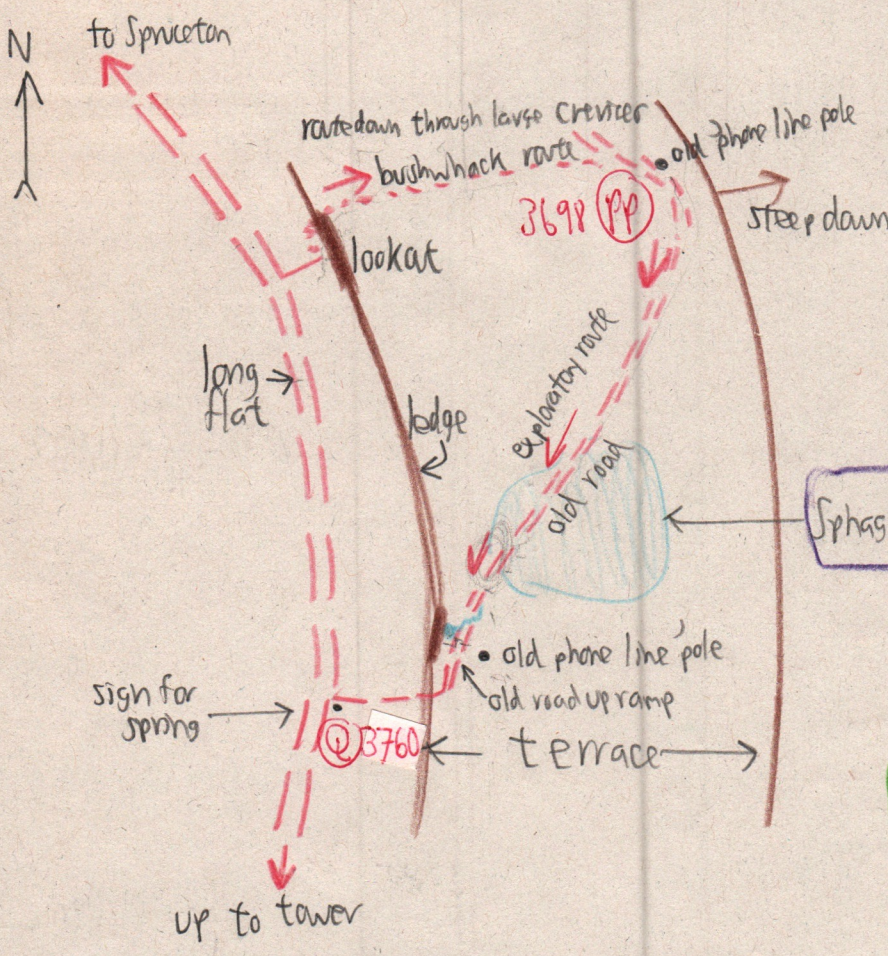

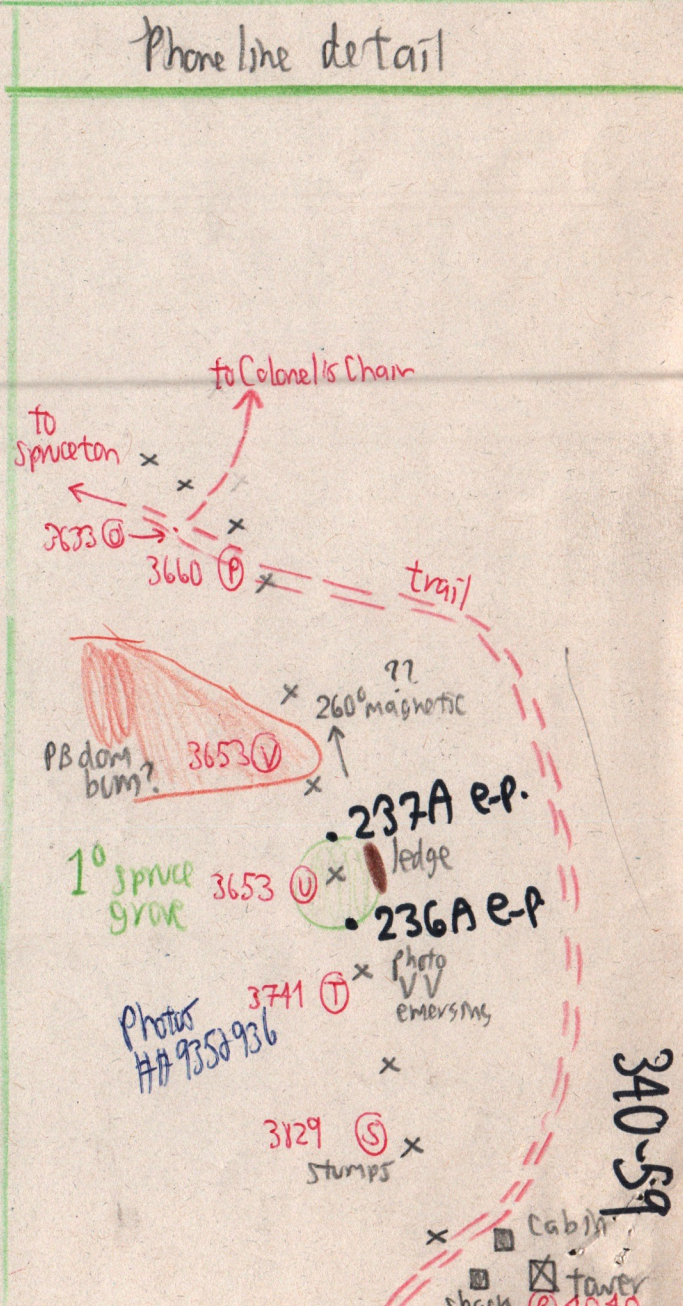
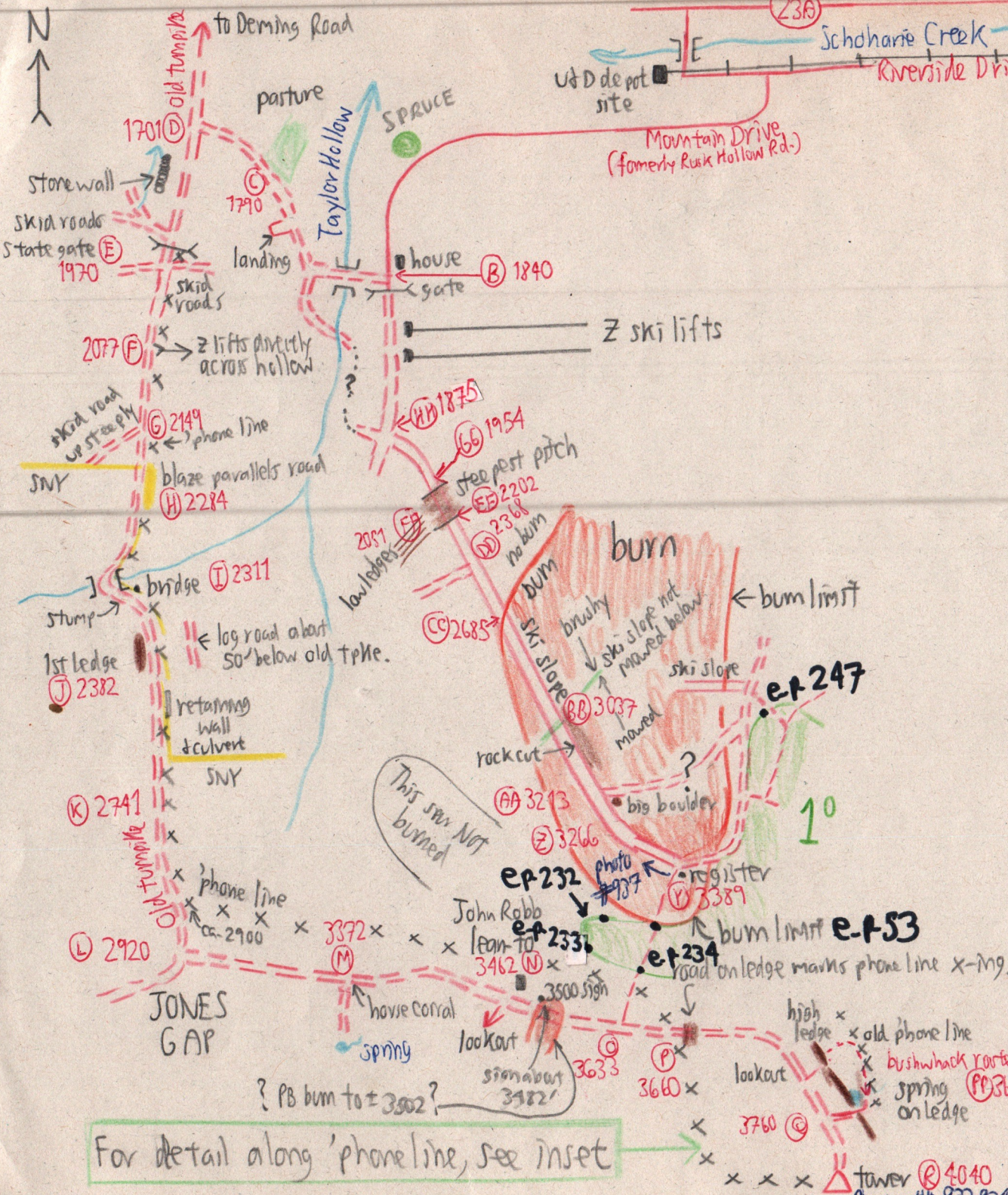
- ⓑ 1140 to Ⓒ 1790: SUG-B-HEM-YB-ASH
No obvious signs of a burn.
- Ⓒ 1790 Yang spruce to 20', OST, Gray birch, apple, Ewh pine. old pasture
Then several 12" SPRUCE with repro.
- Ⓓ 1701 to Ⓔ 1970 HEM 4" to 12" forming
nearly pure stand, with repro.
Old field white pine to 24".
Dead 21" OST w side of take.
ASH. Scattered SPRUCE to 12"
- Ⓕ 1970 to Ⓕ 2077: HEM decreasing; SUG-B increasing, YB.
- Ⓖ 2077 = BASSI, ASH.
- Ⓘ ASH to ± 2350'.
- Ⓚ 2741': 10" Brgtooth down on road.

- Ⓒ to Ⓓ to Ⓔ Recent logging: stumps
skid roads. Probably 1985 to 1990 era
with bark still on stumps.
few stumps or skid roads above Ⓔ 2149
along the old take. Exceptions: a
road below, not connecting, at Ⓙ and
a stump* at Ⓢ 2311. 2312
- No obvious burn vegetation in the
whole area.
- *The stump at Ⓢ is older with
bark coming off.
- Ⓔ 22" SUG stump about 100 years old.
- Ⓚ to Ⓛ to Ⓝ: No recent logging or burn
evidence, but lack of old trees suggests
19th century logging. No stumps No
skid roads.
- Ⓝ to Ⓞ PB dom at ± 3502. A local burn?
at Bug # 347
- Ⓞ From the lookout to the Spring, the terrace
below was examined. SPR to 12" x 50'
only, with FIR & PB, but big YB. Logged for
Spruce, not YB. Old phone line follows old
log road on terrace. SORB 17".
- Sphagnum may be worth sampling.
- See detail on
other page.
- Ⓤ 3653 Large SPR ✓
suggest a 1° pocket.
- Ⓥ 3653. PB dom suggests ✓
a burn.
- Ⓟ Some stumps with logs, some without, under
newer pavline, ∴ 2°. No SPR > 18".
