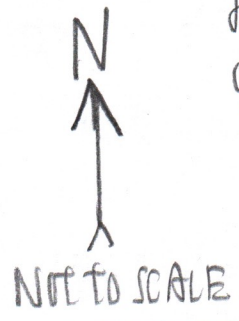

NORTH DOME FROM ALLABEN 361-4



T51 tannery at Shandaken Center closed in 1864 or 1865. The buildings were converted into F469, the Whitney Chair Factory + sawmill in 1870. The initial logging which set off the red oak "explosion" between 1845 + 1858 preceded the Whitney factory so was done by another outfit.

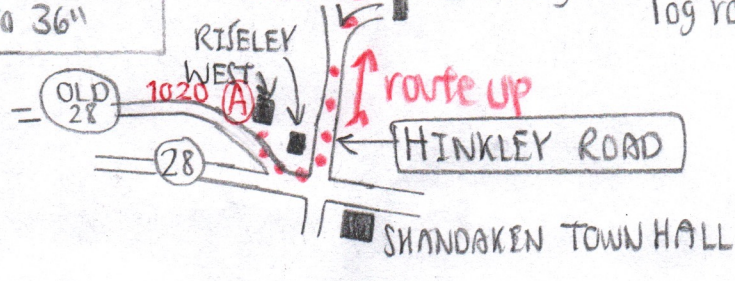

Ed West surveyed these red blazes for the oak logging operation. Logging began before 1975, in 1975 + to about 1978. Oaks ± 120 years on stumps 24" to 36"

- red blaze **HH** 2040
- GG** ledge runs length (width?) of ridge crest 1965
- FF** 1st ledge 1870
- red blaze **EE** 1770
- DD** 1675
- CC** 1520 logging for oak 1965-1970
- BB** 1165 last houses, road ends + splits into log roads

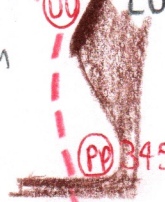
