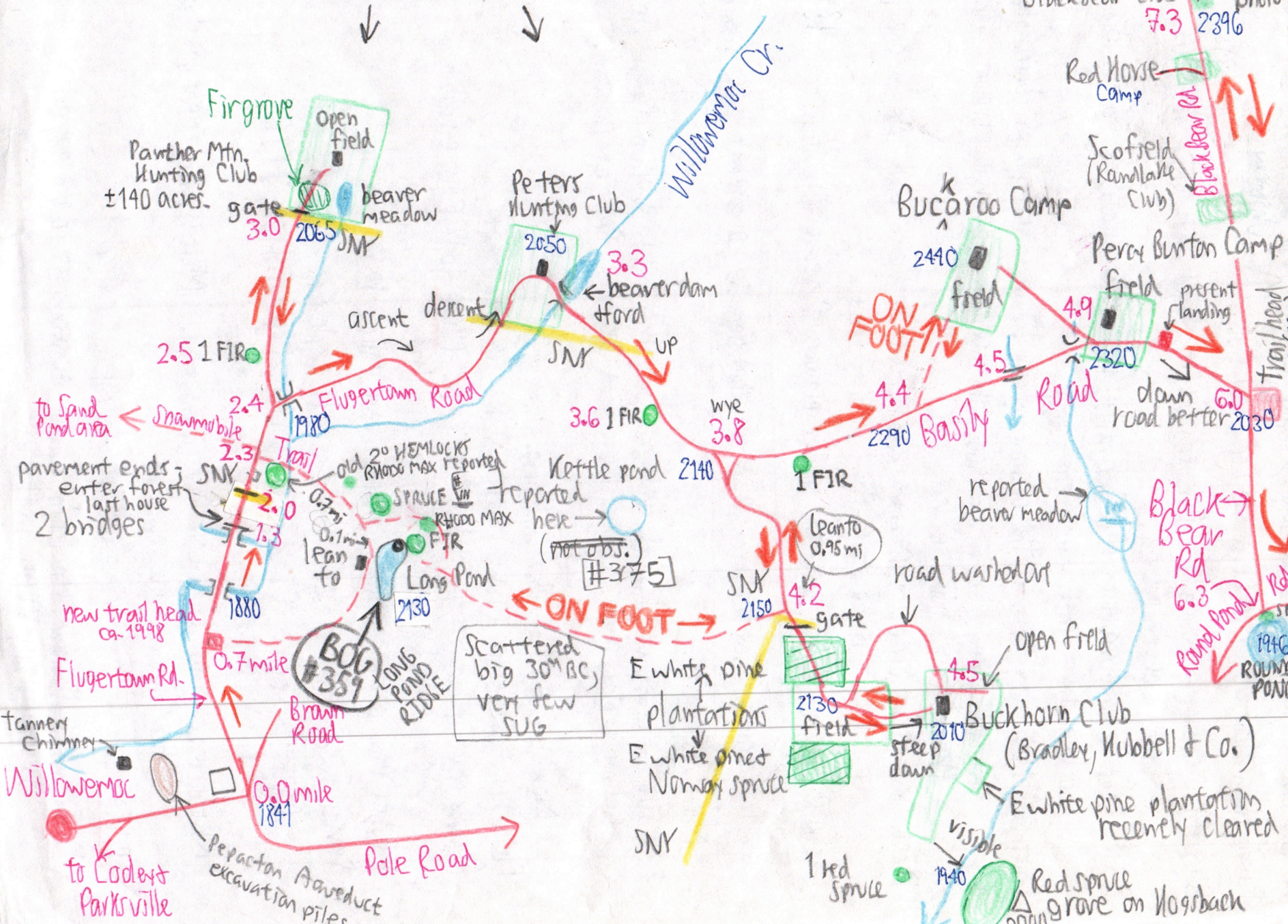




Route → → Elevations in feet in blue

Supplemental Historical Notes

Willowemoc chimney - is a tannery chimney ^{NO (3333) An Acid Wood Chimney}

Flugertown Rd. - Fluger's (Fishing) Rod & Reel Co.

Blue Hill ski slope - bought by a European outfit, Niederhold Corps ^(late?) in 1950s, built & never opened.

Bassly Road is a corruption of Beardsley Rd. The Beardsley Family had a large tract incl. Buckhorn Camp

Panther Mtn. Hunting Club - the opening was 1st used for piling bark peelings for the tannery. Later, ca. 1900, old hemlock logs were brought there & used. Present cabin built early 1960s

Doctor Davis from Livingston Manor owned Buckhorn Camp and put in the plantations ca. 1923. Beardsley's farm prior to that.

Cherry Ridge is name given to ridge between Pigeon & Biscuit Brooks ^{!?! Not Mike's name!?!}

3.6 mi from trail junction ^N of Long Pond to Black Bear Rd. according to DEC sign board

More Vegetation

Few SUB on Long Pond Ridge, the ridge between Long Pond & Buckhorn Camp. The site cannot explain why. Looks like a good SUB site. RM abn instead. Scattered 30"+ BCs.

More SUB ETS of Bunton Camp.

Field SW of Buckaroo Club: Aster umb & Arundo clare

Norway spruce planted around Black Bear Club. PHOTO looks E to cleavert on Wildcat Mtn. (by Frost Valley) & Slide Mtn.

E white Pine along W Branch below Frost Valley. Veraclem in fl.

Spruce Swamp N of Long Pond needs exploring.

Much spr repr. CINN, HEM, KLAT, Cortis Grass, 1 FIR.

15" to fill in deepest probe in Sphagnum

Rhodo. max. obs. N of Long Pond along trail. More reported NW of there on far side of spruce swamp.

PHOTO looking SW from Buckhorn Camp to Fir Brook.

South end of Panther Mtn. Club around beaver meadow & gate. Several FIR, VCAS in fl. abn.
