Canopy 40 to 50', 1 ASH.
NO evidence of 2nd growth,
but NO big trees either

(J) 2923' : 2 large HEMLOCK + 2
medium spruce - 1st conifer
since bog (G)

Brachyelytrum open area.

(K) 2806' . Large SUG above 1st ledge
on descent. Spruce + Hem on top
of ledge. Last spruce seen along
trail. First growth at ledge top.

Leave 1st Growth ca. 2750'

(L) 2709' Second growth at ledge base.
ASH begin with 60' canopy +
DAK a little below. No stunting

in old clearing which might have
been used to pasture quarry horses
& oxen. Foundations of quarrymen's
house & barn?

(AA) 1624' : Cystopteris bulbifera + BIGTOOTH

(BB) 1473' : SUG-B-ASH-DAK - all 2nd growth
BASS above

(CC) 1973' to 1974' = CHARCOAL on low terrace

PB + BB above (CC) with DAK, a
1x burn [ASSIGN NO. TO BURN]

(DD) 2148' : Scat PB, BB, DAK : BURNED 1x
3 Asters: macro, div + acum.

(EE) 2380' : out of burn. SUG dom,
Hystrix, Mitella, PA in Cove

Mt. Tremper 7.0 mi

Route 214 (Edgewood) 0.9 mile

In Carl-Tremper Col.:

Mt. Tremper 1.6 mi

Warner Cr. 2.0 mi

Silver Hollow 5.4 mi [in notch]

Willow 1.8 mi

- hike from Silver Hollow Notch to Willow = $5.4 + 1.8 = 7.2$ mi

June 2000: Pete Fenteman, Jim Daley & Co. in process of building trail on S side of Warner Cr.. Trail already marked on Silver Hollow Mtn.
