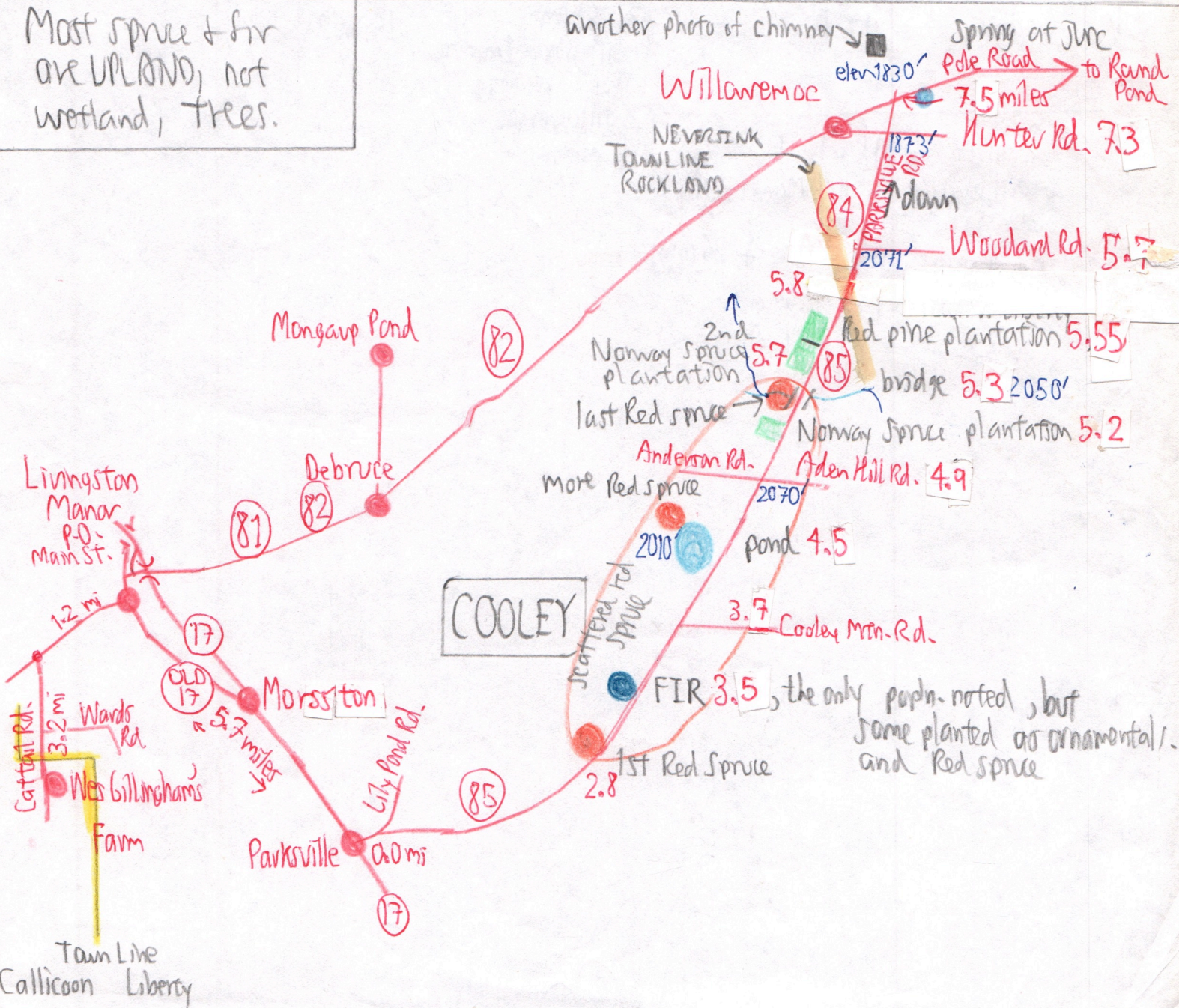
## PARKSVILLE (at COOLEY)

### Background:

- ① Reported in Mammie Wakefield (1970, p 310) spruce at Parksville shipped at on the OtW. '01?
- ② Brian Schiffino on 6/10 reported these populations along the Parksville-Willowemoc Road.
- ③ MK traveled Route 17 between Livingston Manor + Parksville on both 6/10 + 6/11 and found NO red spruce. Norway spruce commonly planted. Hemlock, Pines

Most spruce + fir are UPLAND, not wetland, trees.
