E OX-LL-TR-\$-MEDEOLA MC-DP-MO-LVUL-ERY few SUB on narrow boulder crest. HAMAM.

F MG thicket about 20 to 30y prob. following a small canopy gap Fish SUB cake from 17" tree. <25% stone. Depth of roots 18" to 24"

G LAP, AA, RG, MM, ILEX MONT at spring. No other seep spp.

L Fir grove on E shoulder Largest 6" x 25' several plus >4 dozen saplings. popln increasing. SORR feeding.

M Search Lookart: VACC mnb SORBS DROLEA NEMO ILEX MONT VCASS FIR saplings } high & dry

N One Stump. B, YB, ridge. Grand cover

O Ledge with SORBS

P Woodhull Summit (named after an early settler) BC & B dom. BC to 22" x 40' tall. YB, MO, RM TB, \$ Camm, OX

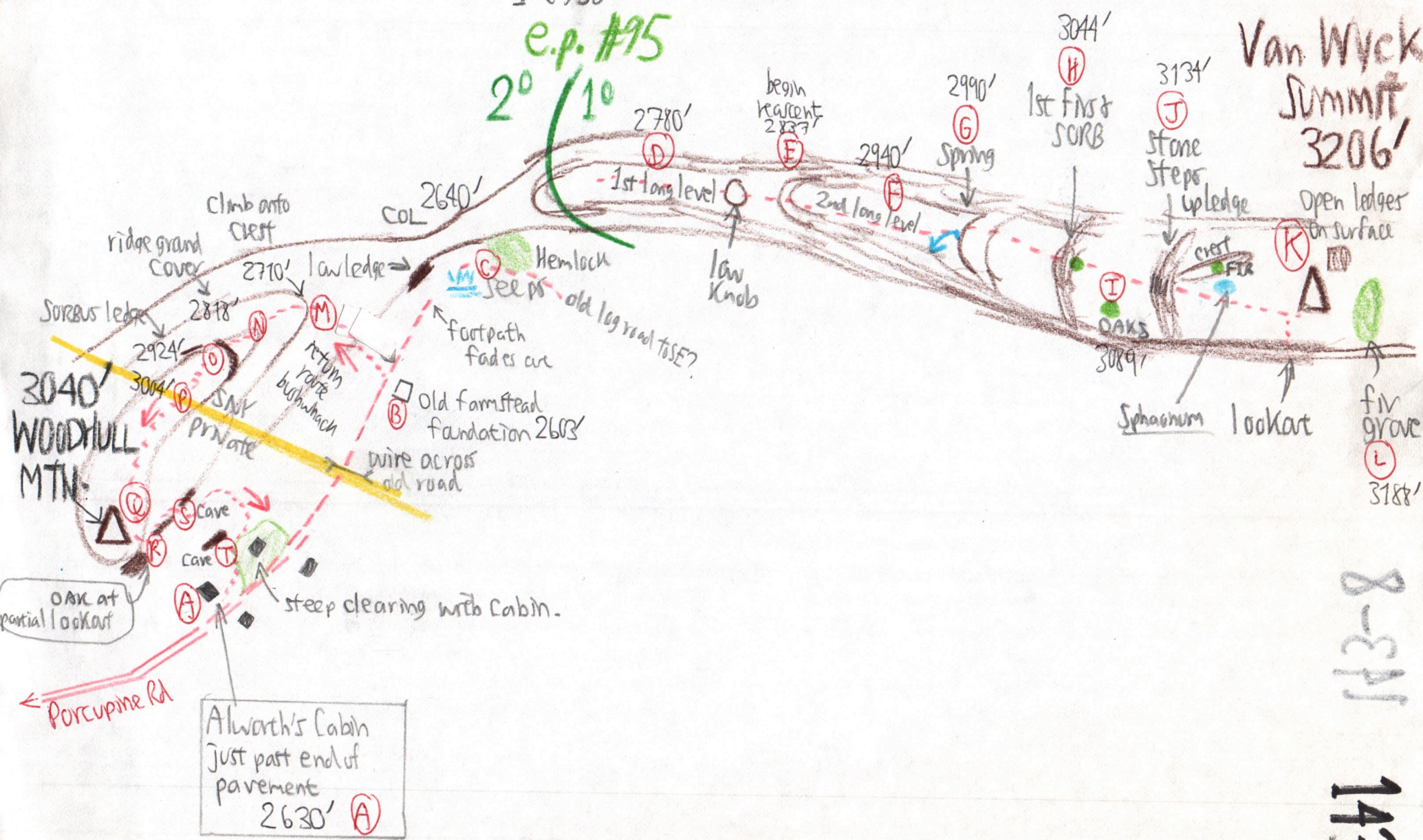
R Oak at partial lookart down onto house across the road from Alwarth Cabin One 6" SUB.

S & T Small caves in the ledges

This lookart is spectacular once the fog rose after a near 2-hour wait. Not vertical like Giant's Newman's Ledges, but almost, & more than twice as high, View from Bear Hole Brook & over to Peckhamose Mtn See 1987 notes (Photo)

← from (G) to (K) is an intermittent headpath, obscure in some places & obvious (as at (J)) in others →
