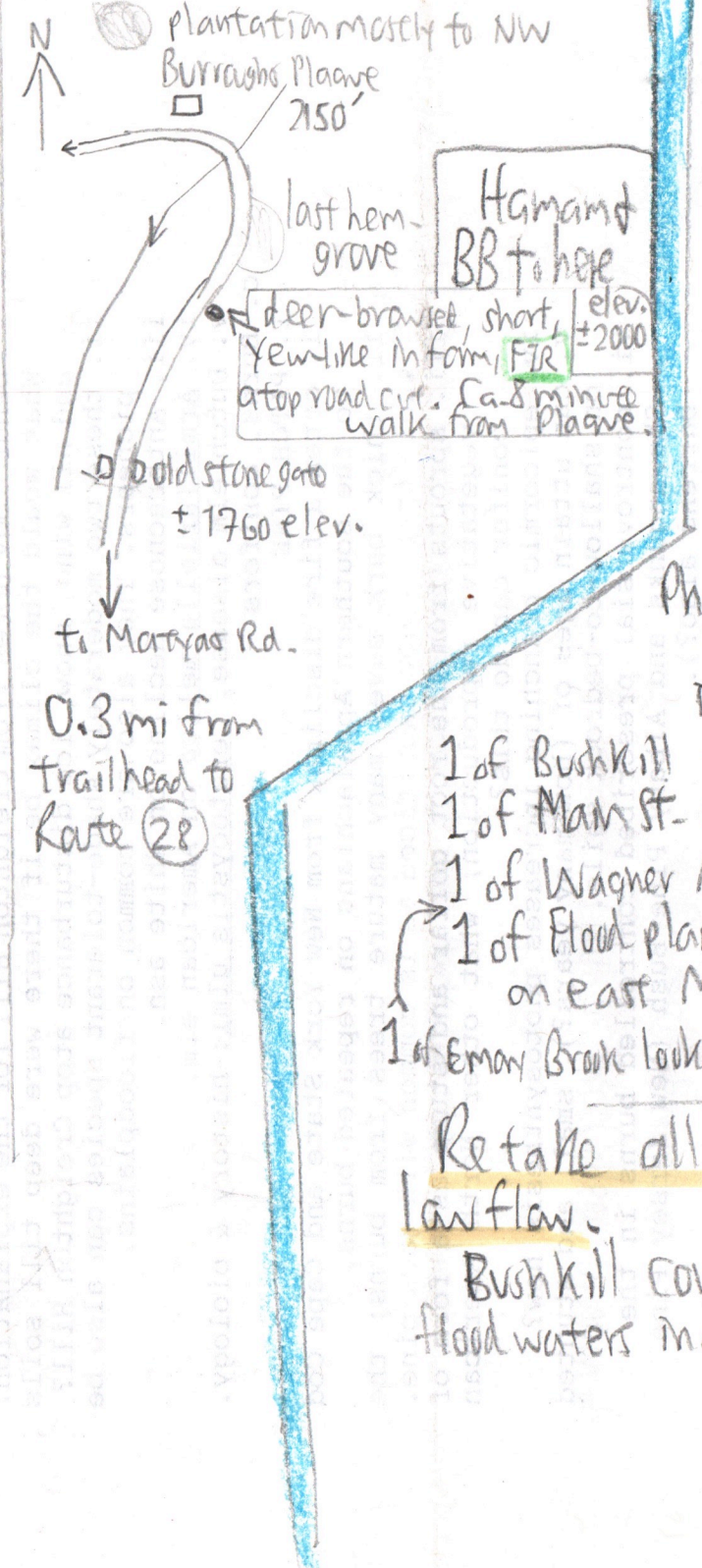

Hot & sunny to noon [meeting with Wray 9:30 to 8:30] From after 12:30 to 5^{PM}, nearly constant thunder & frequent dampers. Vly Creek swollen, but Emory Brook in flood RED.¹ Most thunder seemed stalled off to the east & Halcott Mtn. must have been inundated. Then 1hr. power outage.

- 1 of Bushkill from Bridge St. west
- 1 of Mam St. in front of OLD firehouse
- 1 of Wagner Avenue under Emory Brook
- 1 of Flood plain of Emory Brook behind a garage on east Mam St, above Halcott Rd. junc.
- 1 of Emory Brook looking downstream just below EMam St. bridge.

Retake all the sites for comparison during low flow.

Bushkill could be seen from Unit 8 with red flood waters in a hurry, maybe 10MPH.

The Raymond Riordan School
(pronounced "Rye'-or-dan" by Diane Galucha
& John Wadlin) was located at Lake Shot-o-shoe (?)
near Burroughs' Slabslides at West Park. The
staff & students were neighbors of Burroughs.
School ran from 1914 to ca. 1940. The
memorial sign was put up by the school and
the trees planted (see Van Valkenburgh, 1985)

ROSE (ROCHESTER) CAMP

Rose Camp (later rebuilt? by Colonel Rochester into a mansion) was located
0.6 mile W of Burroughs Monument. Building is shown on N side of road on 2220'
contour, roughly midway betw. Matyas (Rochester Hollow) & Rose Mtn. Roads, on
1960' West Kill Quad. The bldg. also shown on 1900 Phoenician Quad
prob as the Rose Camp.

Beth says, Rose Family owned it in 19th Century. Colonel Rochester ^{From Eighner}
acquired it ~~after~~ ^{before} (1915) World War I, occupying it until ~~1940s~~ ¹⁹⁵⁶. DEC demolished
the dilapidated ruins in 1980s plus a garage bldgs. Some Eurasian plantings
should still be there.

Beth sent Alan via a photo given to her by a Rochester(?) descendant.
Alan wanted peaks in background identification checked. Photo sent attached
to his message of 3/25/13. MK looked at topo-maps:-

- ① Fir Mtn. line up over 1920 ft level on Ganetian Ridge so Rose Camp, at 2220', is well above Ganetian.
- ② Spruce Mtn line up over 2384' knob on W spur of Panther betw. Hatchery & Little Peck Hollows. OK.
- ③ Wilmistock Lake (not visible in photo) should line up over 1st knob ^{new} SE of Big Indian Station.

DEC built ^{new} trails in the area (ask the Rudge ~~man~~) & a lean-to on the
site of the Rochester Camp.
