

Woodland Valley file: Roxmoor Inn.

Dakin Morehouse, of Empire State RY Museum  
(and descendant of Town of Morehouse  
Settlers in Hamilton County),

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reports that John Burroughs stayed at  
also Roxmoor Inn. This is in addition  
to Larkin's Farm.

The building still stands as #124, and  
was once the site of Woodland P.O. (or P.O.  
just next door?).

1875 Beers' Ulster Co. Atlas — no detail

1886 Van Loan Map in 1892 Greene Co. Directory — Beech Flat is Not  
head of Dougherty Brook under Grant ledge.

1871 Child's Gazetteer & Directory, Ulster Co: — no detail

1880 Silverstein Ulster Co. History — no detail

1884 Beers History of Greene Co. (yes, Greene) — same as 1886 Van Loan

Which map has Rouch Flat then?

1879 Van Loan Map shows Beech Flat at west end, pp. 2 & 3 & 88 of  
his Guidebook.

1899 Forest Commission NY Catskills Land Map — no detail.



# Woodland Valley historic sites related to present sites.

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Traveling with Paul Misko to Snyder's Switch, 11/13/07

Compare with 1875 Atlas

Paul says that Simpson owned, or had the bank rights to; Tremper Mtn, Terrace Mtn, the ridge behind Misko Cabin on EAST side of Woodland Creek. Snyder's territory must have been on the W & N sides of Woodland Creek and E side.

Paul says Pantherkill Rd once crossed over Panther Mtn & connected with Pantherkill Rd in Escopus drainage ??? NO
