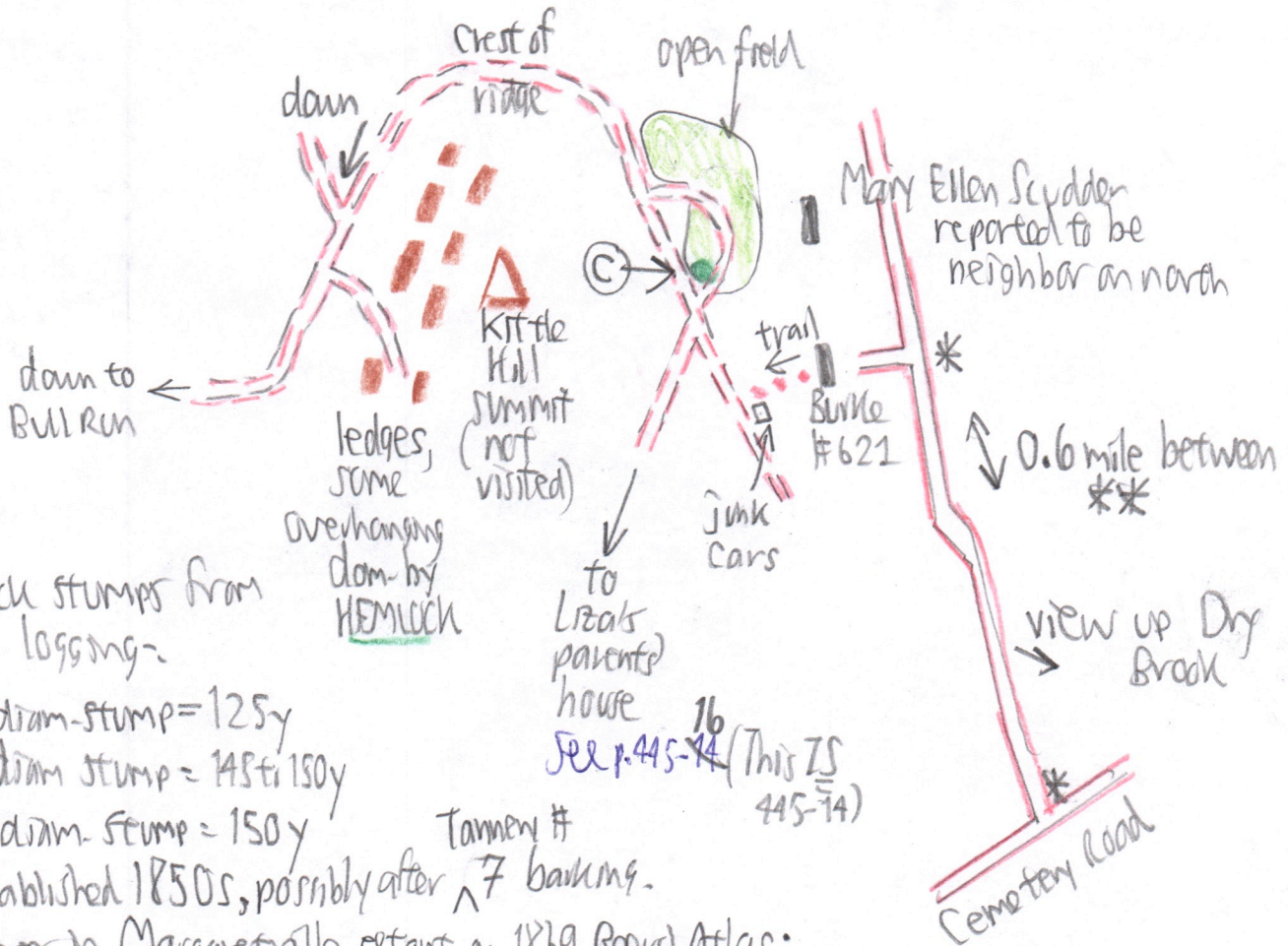

© = *Comus racemosa* in middle of a rose thicket.
Lvs narrow, with only 3 or 4 ven lateral pairs,
and dome-like (not flat) inflorescence.

Epipactis scattered between © + house.

West slopes, in addn to hemlock,
are RM, YB, BB, PB, ASH, 1 big tooth, maybe some N. red oak.
NO white oak, Ch-oak, chestnut,
mtn laurel, or hickories.



Hemlock stumps from 2006 logging =

- Tree 31 20" diam. stump = 125y
- Tree 32 18" diam stump = 145+150y
- Tree 33 21" diam. stump = 150y

established 1850s, possibly after Tannery #7 banking.

Tanneries in Margaretville extant on 1869 Beaver Atlas:

These #1, p. 156, #T6 & T7:

T6 ran from 1863 through at least 1880 (upstream)
T7 was running in 1856 & 1869.
