

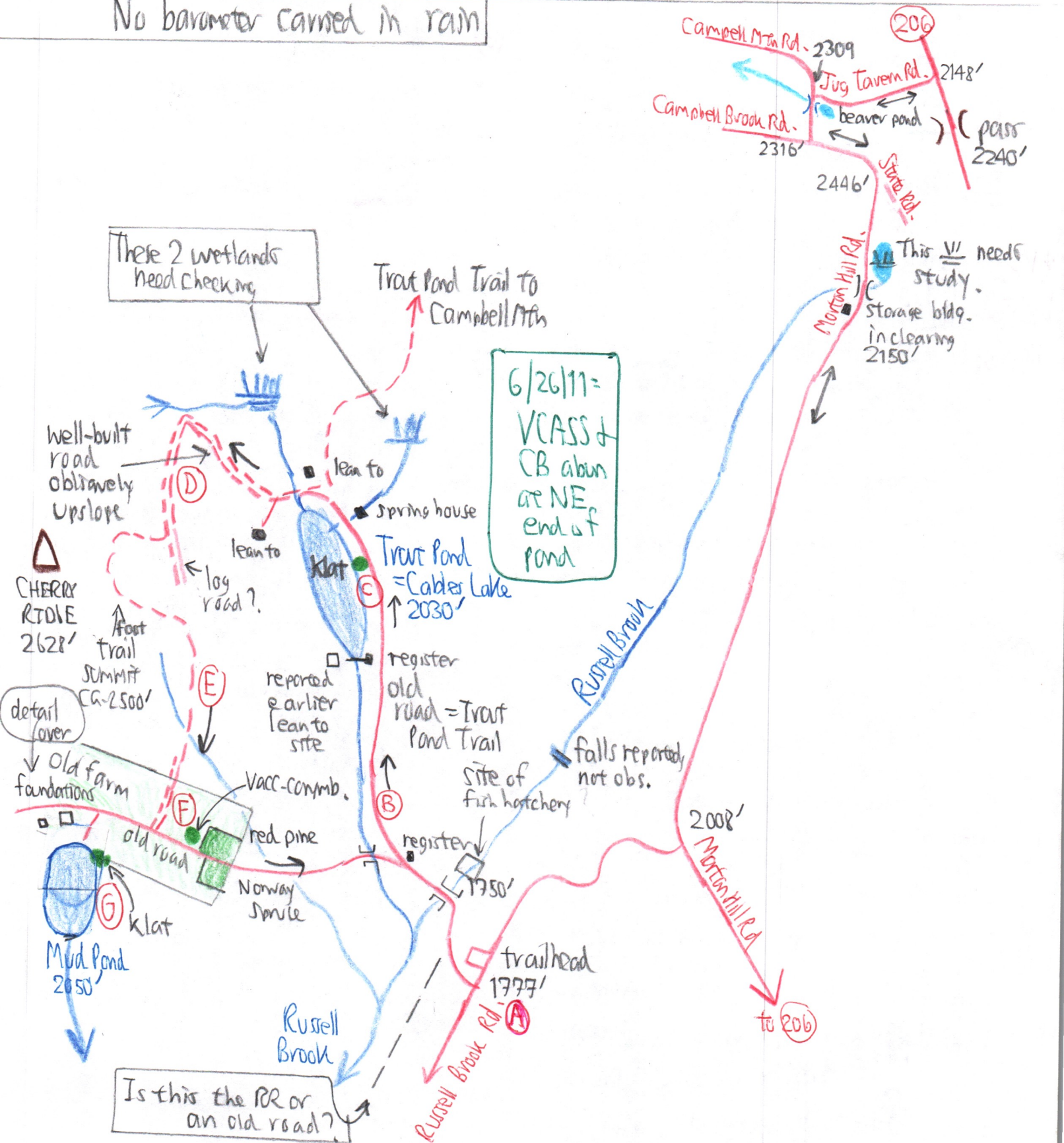

Vegetation

(A) Drymilla on bank, E side of road

This area needs study of
aban. Trex RR terminus

(B) TU in flower. Old hemlocks,
but N h/dws are not old.

(C) Tract Pond has a reported man-made
dam, raised by a beaver dam.
Not obs. Aban. lean to site on
SW cor of Pond.

E shore of Pond: large CB patches.
TU common, especially near spring
house. Boreal ground cover

Klat popln. along pond shore
another at Mud Pond. None
anywhere else. ∴ planted?

Also a large stand on (30) just
W of Beech Hill Rd, S side.

(D) SUB+TB, some ASH but BC dom.
Chem Ridge is well-named.
Prob. 75 to 100 y old.

(E) A few ± 40y old stumps. Was
the area acquired by SNY in
1960s? Check. Acid wood
earlier cut, in early 20th century,
resulted in mainly a BC forest,
NOT oak-ash-BB. Compare
this with Arkville area.

Vacc. corymbosum.

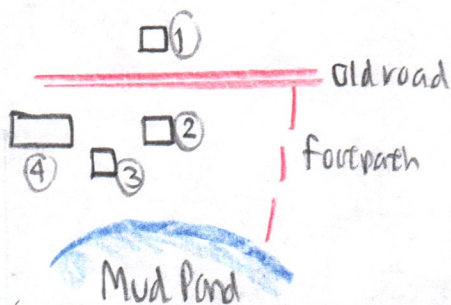
(G) Mud Pond edge

Foundations:

(2) is a barn with a hay loft ramp
+ a 18" BC growing inside
the foundation

(4) is concrete + large—a substantial
bldg. Maybe a hotel or mill,
not a farm house.
Bricks were made by NEBCO
(look up in brick industry book).
