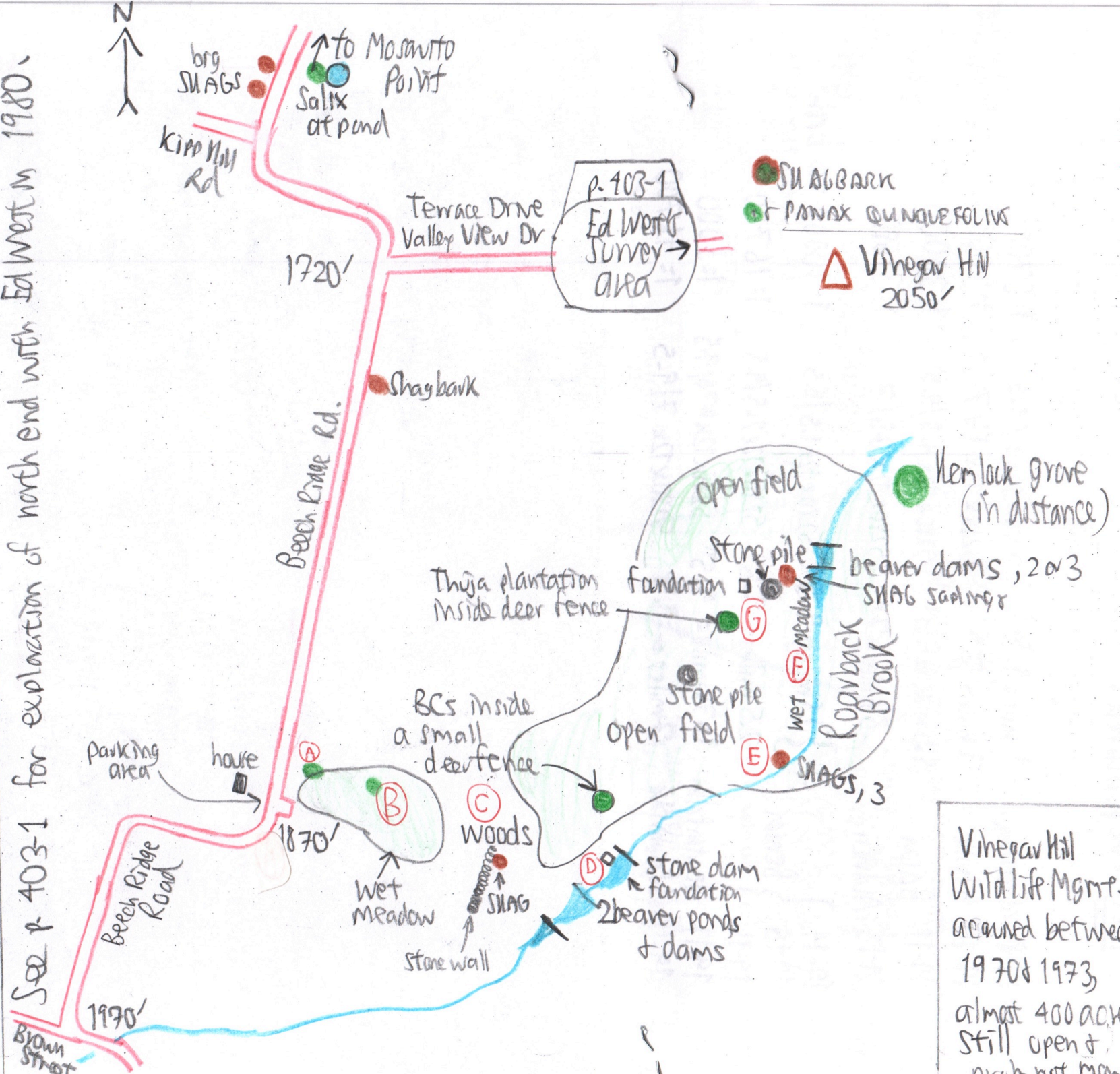

Vinegar Hill Wildlife Mgmt. Area  
 acquired between  
 1970 & 1973  
 almost 400 acres Mich  
 Still open &  
 much not mowed

- (A) Salix discolor + bebbiana  
N edge of parking area
- (B) S. sericea in wet area in middle of field
- (C) Old field now young woods, almost all a RM pole stand now. 10" SNAG at stone wall.
- (D) Beaver pond, lodge & dam  
Below is a human-made pond with stone dam & a foundation in an odd place for a mill. No waterpower or mill race here above the dam.  
Few dead trees around beaver pond & none in meadow surrounding.  
SPIRAEA lat, Solidago rug & Rubus hispidus. APPLE.

- (E) One 2" SNAG + two smaller saplings  
Humulus, non-native currants planted. SAMS CAN.  
Salix sericea
- (F) No dead trees in wet meadow SPIRAEA lat dam.
- (G) Two huge stone piles, reminiscent of those on the N side of Kenny Hollow (Hill Road) Ridge off DBR and those in Kanape Valley, Instead of stone walls

Thuja grove planted, each with a deer fence. JVA. Seneca at ponds  
S. bebb higher up with S. discolor.  
SNAG saplings browsed & sprouting  
Senecio aureus, a few in fl.  
In wet meadow  
Lentago + Lilac planted.  
Solid amca  
Aster umb.  
Cornus racemosa?  
BB, HAMAM  
2 butternuts
