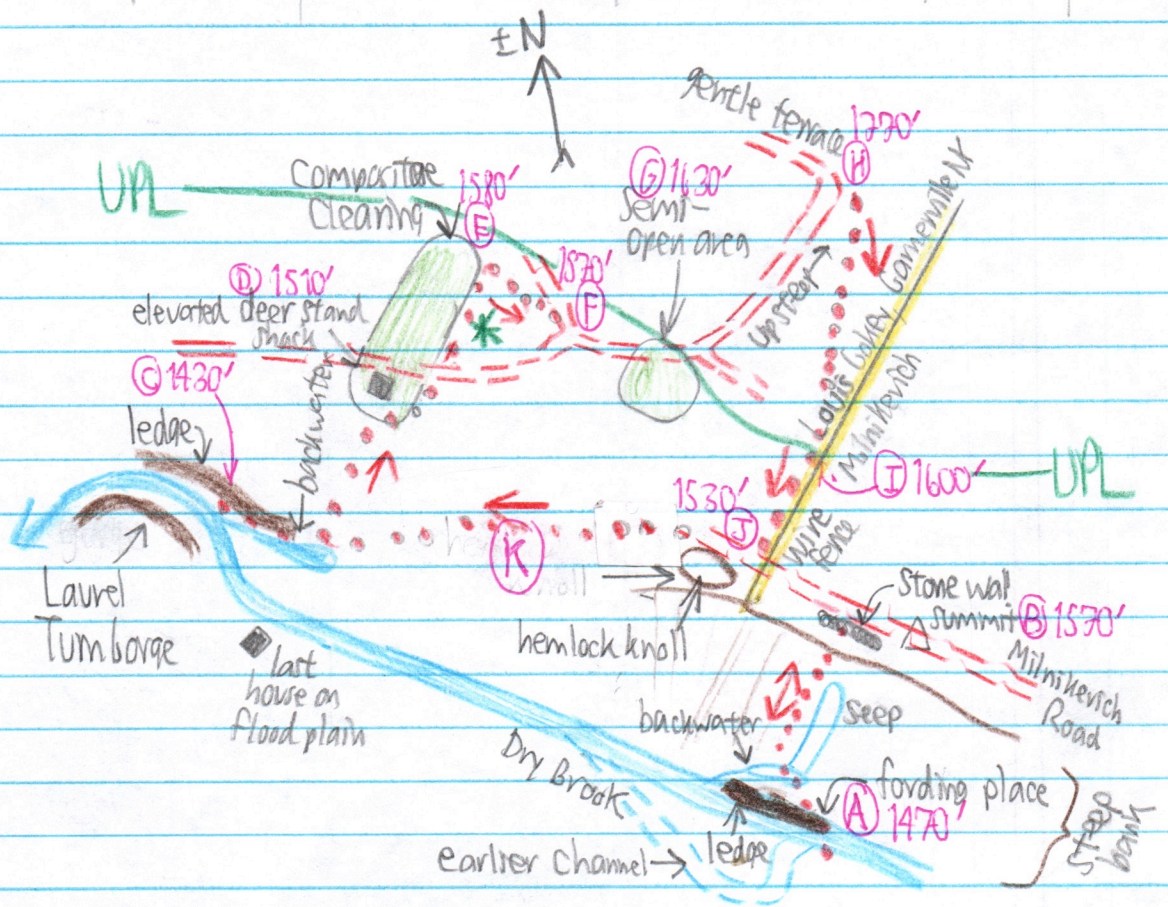

(G) (H) Leave old pasture.

(H) Traffic noise on Dry Brook Rd. audible
about 300 ft above it.

Older trees RM dom, BB, B understory.
Open woods. Stumps 30 to 35y ±.

(H) (I) 30" sub in small LAP glade.

(I) Milkweetch sign on 28" RM along blaze.
UPL. Wire between properties.

(B) (J) 140 MK paces ≈ feet between (B) + (J).
Seep with Brachy-rhizale (?) dominance.

UPL (Upper Pasture Limit) ranges from (E) to (G) to (I), with calculated elevs of 1580', 1630',
and 1600', respectively. Fleischmann's 1945 Quad. shows it at a near-
constant elev. of 1620', almost on contour.
