(B) : One plant of Cypripedium acule in flower

Just above register. Stone wall makes a 90° bend ± 1/2 way up to (BB) junction

(C) 3 carp, bright orange, in pond. Also called Koifish (Coy fish?). Could date back to pond creation in 1960s? Up to a foot long ± maybe >50y old?

Senecio aureus in flower in 2 populations—
① along inlet brook to pond
② in seep along outlet brook
Rhubarb plant (one) below pond. Emm picked it.

(D) The inlet brook to the pond emerges as a spring below the cabin, which must have served as a water supply.

Norway spruce, the northernmost four is very close to the inlet brook. dbhs: 26", 22", 20", 21". Growing 12" to 24" / year in height. Estimated heights 100 to 110 ft. Age probably only 50y

Cabin ruins in a YB pole stand. Electrification of cabin prob. came in 1960s not 1930s hermit era.

(E) 2474' This point, at NE end of a narrow terrace, MK turned SW along terrace on 41161 bar site (F). Emm left us here. No roads, no stumps, but no old trees either

(F) 2647' On crest of sp. w. BC ± SUB co-dominant

2721 (J) 1st DP glade. Quite small under 1 dead + 1 dying SUBS. David found mystery plant—what looked like a BC seedling but with some lvs. opposite.

(H) 2801' "Bony" terrace flat with BC dom. 28" YB on ledge above.

(I) 2893' 1st SUB grave with dblr 24" to 25" x 80 ft ± 29" x 32". One fallen broken SUB 18" diameter has rings averaging 2 to 3mm in radius. Estimated age only 86y??

The seep ground cover flora is along the terrace a short distance to south.

Coming down from the mod. steep ledgy, bouldery slope above, which continues on up to Graham Summit.

1 ASH seedling. OS MO, TIAR, CAULO, VC, SOLID LINT, ALL, DICENTRA, SAMB HYDRO. BC REPRO.

2721 (J) Pass lowest DP glade again
(JJ) 1-52. Several MO pole stands mark old blowdown- 21" healthy beech.

(G) 2700' Highest stump, ca. 50y, prob. dating to 1960s. Gentle slope with a few more stumps below, then the beginning of a faint skid road.

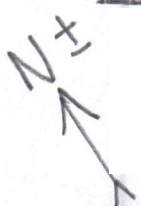
(L) 2640' BEARDUNG HEMLOCK GROVE with abundant dung. 11 hemlocks, 8" to 20", no saplings, on flat ledge. In 2nd hardwoods area, but bark peelers prob. never got here.

(M) 2526' Follow log road down, heading N, then E, then S. No more ledges. ASH.

(N) 2372' Large DP area but shaded with 1 BASS. SUB dom.
