C "Hornbeam Farm" is barely 1 acre, and doesn't look as much an old pasture as it did on April 16, 2016. Also, apple, K&T other young hardwoods mixed in with semi-open goldenrod & a stone pile on a steep terrace.

C The gully above is 6 to 8 ft deep in till to ledge.

F Spring questionable in stone foundation. No pipe obs. this day. NEM scattered.

Pass owl can 10:38 AM
NEM grove above on steep bank, but above bank where slope is gentler N-hdwds. dominate

G Above this point, log road becomes very obscure, might be locally washed out: road, gully, or both?

H SUB-ASHL with B saplings & sprouts. NO stumps until **J**. Not logged in 1960s, but prob. 2°. Above the terrace, slope does not abruptly climb steeply here. SUBs to 22"

Terrace narrows & becomes bouldery from steeper talus slope above. Scatt. hemlock on talus.

I Terrace continues with 24" SUBs, 18" ASH, LAP gullies

II Terrace ends.

Above it is an upper short terrace, then a uniform moderate slope down to Dry stream. 11-10 SUBs to 12". NEMs scatt. above

J 1st stump on SE side of stream only about 15 ft above it. Powerline across stream visible. Loggers must have crossed the stream in the 1960s here & taken several trees out.

Dry stream flows in a gently-sloping LAP glade. K&Bs to 20"

Stump #2

K Lunch stop. Stumps #3 & 4 in a SUB forest. Hemlock scattered above.

Begin Descent

30" & 26" hemlocks, a few seedlings, 24" K&Bs, mixed forest above on talus.

Ledger above upper terrace at **II**

G Road begins between the 2 gullies. The Dry stream is on ledge above the upper confluence. Stumps resume below. NEMs above terrace only 6" to 12".

E NEM grove above on south, but only ±12" as an understory to hardwoods. Cable across log road

D to **L**. Cross 2 gullies at log road gently climb SE, then blowdown, then in wet road cut. Road levels & turns S.

12:46. Ledger above, mostly young SUB to 12" only

L Road on wet flat heads to SSW with log deck (?) goldenrod clearing, mounds & pits excavated. Turn east & bushwhack down towards Flat Iron Brook

M 36" NEM atop severely steepened bank, then 28", 24", 30". All others < 12". Mixed with hardwoods. Stumps above.

Flat Iron brook turns more E and bank gets less severe. Brook on ledge in gorge just above confluence

N Follow a spur down to Dry Brook.

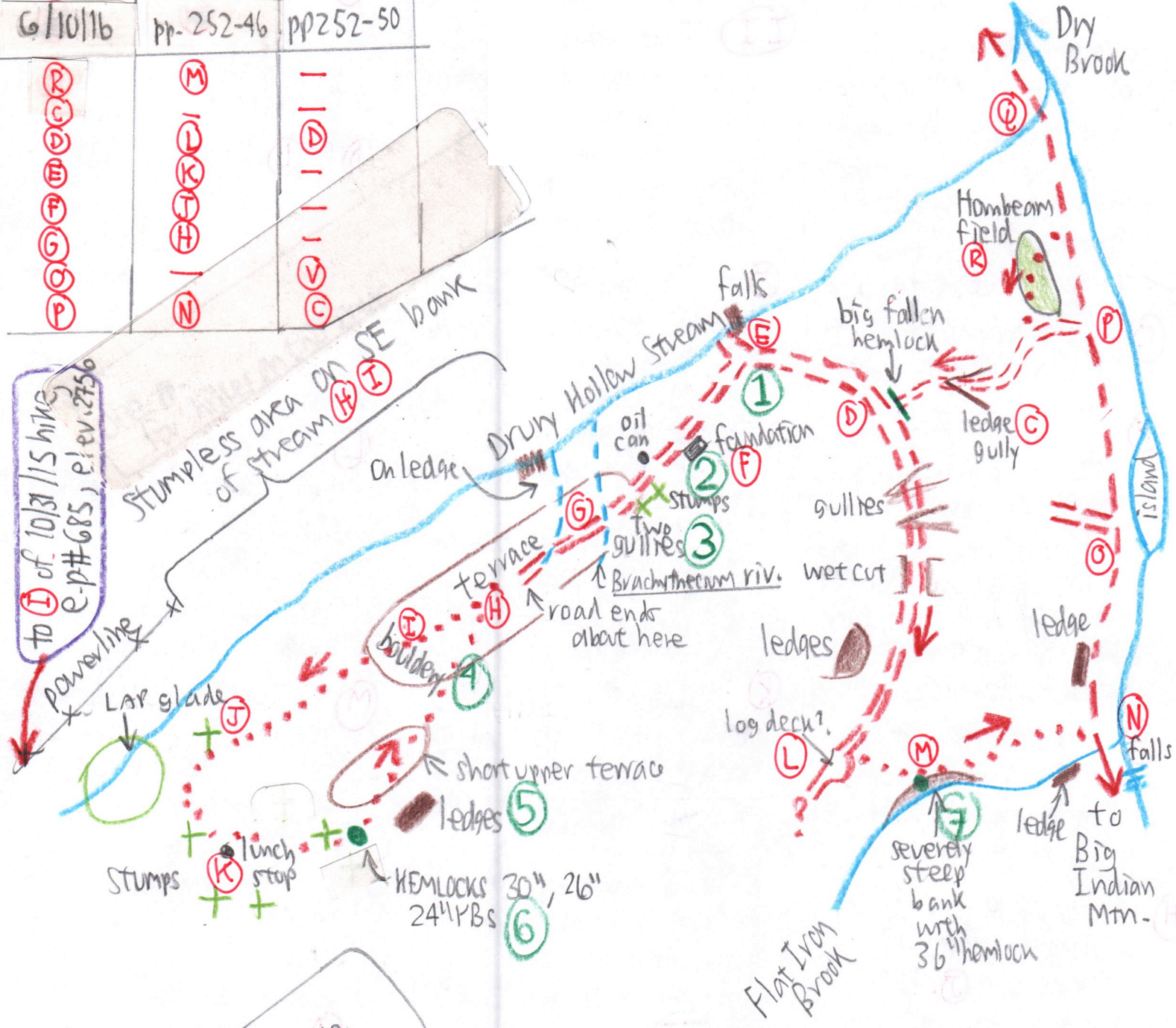

Hemlock detail:

- 1 Understory only, 12" dbh, under hardwoods
- 2 Scattered above F
- 3 grove above, but small with h/wds. on gentler slope farther up
- 4 scattered on talus
- 5 scattered above
- 6 few seedlings. Mature to 30"
- 7 scattered giants.
