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(C) KAYSUTA FALLS
 (Van Kleeck spelling)
 KARASTMA (?) Wadlin spelling
 (John Wadlin spelling)
 is about 18' high on the
 Escopus. B-SUG-
 HEMLOCK with widely
 scattered ASH up to
 the lake.

(E) DEAD HORSE ROAD
 Ends at SNY line (2
 faded yellow blazes on
 10" Beeches just below
 34" YB at base of steep
 bouldery slope. Fresh
pink flagging is DEP
 Conservation easement on
 the Escopus Watershed says
 John. Old foresters'
 faded blue blazes.
 Stumps look 1980s but
 John says 1990s.
 Blaze 230° mag = 217°
 true = H. Patent lot
 line.
 Widely scattered ASH
 to 12". Pink flags
 prob. follow SNY line.

EAST END
 (I) Y-C-RU-CY Lookout
 KEM, SORB, YB, ILEX
 MONT, POLYPODY.
No fir.
 DEP pink flagging
 just below the lookout
 Trail to Y-C-RU-CY
 is NOT a log road!
 (I) to (J) 1-07 FIR seedlings.
 SORB.
 (J) More open forest but
 \$ is still INT with last
 year's lvs. on ground.
 LL, OX, VA, KM, BC, YB,
 B dom.

(K) Compass Rock (Using
 a compass, Thomas Cole Lake
 at Frost Valley is due west).
 Check this. Can't be.

FIR-SORB-YB-CB.
 View from Compass Rock:-
 1. Dabletop, Big Indian
 2. W Branch Never sink has
 interlocking spur from
 entrenched meanders.
 3. S side of W Br. Never-
 sink headwaters has large
 crowns, darker, coarser-
 textured. Directly beneath
 on N side of Nev. crowns
 are smaller, paler, finer-
 textured. Why?
 4. Fir capping 3600'
 Lookout ledge on Steps Trail
 is obvious, above the ridge
 hardwoods.

(KK) Stumps begin.
 1960s maybe. Forest abruptly
 changes from semi-open
 ridge hdwar to Beech.
 Ilex mont profuse understory
 with tiny leaves like OST!
