Bruce Spanworm and Winter Moth Pheromone Trap Survey

The so-called winter moth, *Operophtera brumata*, is an insect pest that was introduced to North America from Europe. The related Bruce spanworm moth (*O. bruceata*) looks almost identical to the winter moth in all life stages, and mixed populations of these species occur in Massachusetts. Both winter moth and Bruce spanworm are attracted to pheromone used for this survey.
