### Instructions

This observation sheet will be used to compare pest problems with growing degree day accumulations which can be found in 1988-89 "Cornell Recommendations for Trees and Shrubs." When filling in information, be as complete and descriptive as possible.

#### Examples:

Date -- date of observation.

Location -- location of observation.

Plant name -- exact name of plant, including cultivar where possible.

Plant phenology -- stage of development such as bud swell, full bloom, leaves fully expanded, etc. Can also include growth stage of nearby plants even if pest is not on these plants (but include name of plant). Use more lines if necessary.

Pest -- insects, diseases, and weeds.

Stage and size -- stage of life cycle and approximate size.

Examples:    insect -- larvae 0.5" long, adults, crawlers, etc.  
                  weed -- seedling, in flower  
                  disease -- spots just starting

All columns do not need to be completed if you are only observing plant phenological characteristics (full bloom, bud swell, leaves fully expanded, etc.)
