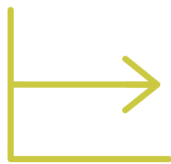

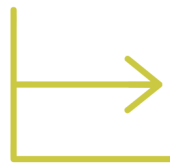
The color of the score denotes the long-term trend
