MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH Application Checklist

ONLINE APPLICATION:

Complete your online application through the University of Vermont Graduate College website.

Tip: You may begin your application at any time, save your progress, and return to it later. While completing your application online, please ensure that you type in all fields manually and do not allow your browser to autofill any fields. The autofill option can cause a delay in the review of your application.

RESUME OR CV:

Your resume or CV will help us to learn more about your background and recommend electives that are best tailored to your career goals.

PERSONAL STATEMENT:

Your personal statement is an opportunity for you to describe your reasons for wishing to undertake graduate study.

Tip: Describe the strengths and weaknesses of your preparation for graduate study in your proposed field. If you are presently in a graduate program, please explain why you wish to apply to a new program. If there are gaps in your academic career, please address them.

THREE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:

You will be required to identify three professional and/or academic references. Your references should be able to provide an informed opinion regarding your motivation, your intellectual ability, your work ethic, and your personal qualifications. We highly recommend that at least one of your references is academic in nature.

OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS:

You will be required to attach official transcripts of all undergraduate coursework and, if applicable, graduate coursework that you have completed, regardless of whether or not a degree was conferred. This includes transfer, international, and study abroad credit. Unofficial transcripts uploaded by you are sufficient for the review process. Official transcripts are only required if you are admitted. Please have official transcripts sent directly from your institution(s) to *graduate.admissions@uvm.edu*. For international applicants, it may be necessary to provide a notarized English translation of your transcripts.

APPLICATION FEE:

After completing your online application, a \$65 application fee will be required prior to submitting your materials. Your payment may be made by credit or debit card.

RESIDENTIAL STATUS QUESTIONNAIRE:

Complete the questionnaire to confirm your eligibility for in-state tuition.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY TEST SCORES:

Applicants whose native language is not English must submit an English proficiency test score with their application materials.
