



ACCELERATED MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH

This course flow example allows undergraduate students to complete their MPH in one year, following graduation with a Bachelor's degree. Undergraduate students who are accepted into the program complete 1-2 online courses and earn 3-6 credits towards their MPH degree during the summer between Junior and Senior year. Immediately following Senior year, students who have met the conditions of the MPH complete the remaining degree requirements.
