The Lake Champlain drainage basin is 8,234 square miles, including Lake George, Lake Placid, and major rivers like the Winooski, Saranac, and Lamoille. About 56% of the basin is in Vermont, 37% in New York, and 7% in Quebec. Lake Champlain and its watershed are stunning natural resources. Let's work together to protect the lake and basin!
