

Marina Survey

Clean boating interest survey conducted December 2016

47 marinas operating on Lake Champlain (Vermont and New York) were contacted by email or phone to respond to questions about their interest in providing clean boating materials and information to their customers and staff.

21 marinas responded (45%).

52%

11 marinas were interested in providing educational materials about aquatic invasive species to their customers.

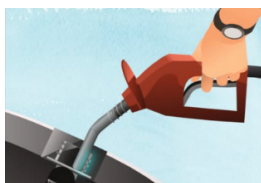

The survey respondents were interested in providing aquatic invasive species educational materials, supplying customers with clean boating supplies, assisting with oil spill clean up efforts in the case of an emergency, and aiding in monofilament recycling programs. The marinas are not interested in fuel or anti-fouling paint application training.
