Answer: Herding in 1983

4. The AKC listed what 3 breeds as the most popular in 2018?
Answer: Labrador Retriever, German Shepherd, Golden Retriever
5. In the obedience ring, what is the length of time that Novice exhibitors have their dogs do the "long sit"? **Answer:** 1 minute
6. What do we call the dog event that includes moving with your dog through an obstacle course? **Answer:** Dog Agility
7. Do you need to have a pure bred dog to show in 4-H? **Answer:** No
8. What is the written record of a dog descent of three generations or more called?
Answer: A pedigree
9. What do we call a nose that is spotted with flesh color? **Answer:** Butterfly Nose
10. What do you call a dog whose sire and dam are representatives of two different but pure breeds? **Answer:** Crossbred
11. How many digits does a dog have on one foot? **Answer:** 4
12. A dog under the age of 12 months is called a? **Answer:** Puppy
