



Become a 4-H Teen Ambassador!

TRY 4-H! is a **leadership opportunity for 4-H members in grades 7-12 (Fall 2019).** This teen-led program is specifically designed to help grow Vermont 4-H. Teens who apply and are accepted will become **4-H Teen Ambassadors**. TRY 4-H! is looking to tap into the passion, knowledge, and experience with 4-H that we know our older members have and love to share!

NEW THIS YEAR! We want more teens to get involved in TRY 4-H! and recognize that teens have pretty busy schedules. So we are offering two different terms of service; **each term will last for 4 months**. The first term will run from August 15—December 15 and the second term will run from January 15 – May 15. In June/July we will bring all Teen Ambassadors together for a **fun celebration of service**—the celebration activity will be decided by Teen Ambassadors (e.g, water park, river float, beach day, etc.).

Teen Ambassadors will serve a 4 month term and will be expected to do the following:

- → Submit an **application by August 1, 2019** and be selected to serve from August 15—December 15. (Applications for the January-May term will be due no later than December 1, 2019.)
- → Attend a mandatory Teen Ambassador training on August 15 from 4-7 pm at the UVM Extension Office in Berlin. All other meetings are held over Zoom, an online meeting platform. You just need a computer or smartphone to connect—or you can call in over the phone. We will meet once per month; date & time to be decided by group.
- → Communicate regularly via email and attend Zoom video conference meetings once a month.
- → Promote 4-H in your community and around Vermont either solo or with other Teen Ambassadors. The goal is to try to do at least 3-4 promotions during your term as teen ambassador. Promotions are anything from exhibit tables, hosting an activity for younger kids, writing a story for your paper, creating a video and posting to Instagram, etc. There are lots of ways to promote 4-H!
- → During the August-December term the focus will be on hosting information and activity tables at school open houses, farmers markets and other events/promotions (e.g. Wag It Forward: Festival for Pets). The focus for the January-July term will be on 4-H State Day. Teen ambassadors will assist in the planning, promotion and staffing of this event. Teen ambassadors in this term may also want to take the lead in planning for 4-H Service Day or host an information and activity table at events (e.g. Burlington Kids Day).
- → Promote 4-H in your community, your county and the around the State; be a positive 4-H role model.
