- Event takes place on Saturday, March 11; snow date is March 19, same time and location.
- Participants check-in starts at 9:00 a.m. and contest starts promptly at 9:30 a.m.
- Cost is \$2.00 per participant; all proceeds to go to the 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl Team.
- Parking is behind the Waterman Building off of College Street.

Bring:

- Your own bag lunch, snacks and beverages.
- A clipboard and two pencils for the written test.
- A buzzer set if you can!

Lunch and final rounds will be decided after the number of participants are known.

Please be prepared to stay until the contest is complete.

We welcome youth and volunteers to 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl and hope that as long as you are healthy, we will see you on March 11. Masks are optional.

The State 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl Team will be selected based on the results of this contest. 4-H Seniors must reach their 15th birthday before September 1 but not have reached 19 years prior to January 1, and not be past their first semester of college to age qualify for the team.
