## FUN TIME!

**Sheep and Goat Camp** gives youth a chance to meet new people who share their interests. This is an educational and fun weekend, with workshops and activities during the day, and a fun group event on Saturday evening for all campers.

## PARTICIPANTS

Open to any youth 8-18 (**as of January 1, 2022**) wanting to learn more about sheep and goats including management, handling, characteristics and breeds, general healthcare, fitting and showing, judging, nutrition, and much more.

All adult participants will assist with the program in some way during camp. Activities begin with registration on **Saturday, June 25**, from 9:00-10:00 a.m. and end with a fun sheep and goat show and more workshops on **Sunday, June 26**.

## CAMP FEE, MEALS, REGISTRATION

- The \$45 fee covers meals, instruction and instructional materials, facilities and a t-shirt. Parents and volunteers are encouraged to attend for the same fee (\$45).
- Each youth must have an adult 4-H chaperone on hand for the duration of the camp. A chaperone may be responsible for multiple youths, but that leader or parent/guardian must register for the entire weekend.
- If you are coming as a visitor and wish to join us for a meal, please pre-register and pre-pay the fee of \$5.00 per meal. This allows us to plan food quantities and helps pay for your meal. Contact your County 4-H Educator for availability of scholarships from your local 4-H Foundation.
- Bring a tent! There is no housing at this site. Participants “camp” in one of the designated buildings or may pitch a tent in a designated area. Participants are responsible for bringing their own sleeping bag/bedding.
- A complete list of items to bring will be sent once your registrations and full payment have been received.

## SHEEP & GOAT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

- Each participant needs a sheep or goat to work with at camp, as if preparing for show. You may bring your own animal or arrange to borrow one. Please indicate on the form below if you need an animal provided for you.
- All sheep/goats must meet health regulations. Sheep/goats 4 months or older must have received a rabies shot at least 30 days prior to camp. Every animal must have a Scrapie tag and be in good health. Proof of vaccination and a health certificate from your veterinarian are required.
- **All animals must be checked before unloading**, and all animals and health certificates will be checked by a camp official upon arrival. If a sheep or goat is lacking a health certificate or is found to be unhealthy or is transported with any infectious condition, it will not be admitted.
