- Plastic boots will be provided for the participants first, then to spectators (if available). **If you have rubber boots that can be washed, please wear them.**

Directions

Take Route 36 East to Fairfield Center School.
Turn left onto North Road near the school
Continue for 0.7 miles, turn right onto Chester A. Arthur Road
Continue for 2 miles, turn left onto Wanzer Road
Continue for 1.1 miles
The farm bunker will be on the right side of the road and barn sits off on the right.
