



# 2024 State 4-H Horse Communications Contest

## Contest Details:

- 4-H members compete in three speaking categories:
  - Public Speaking (no props or charts, 7–10 minutes)
  - Individual Demonstration (charts and visuals mandatory, 9–12 minutes)
  - Team Demonstration (2 people, charts and visuals mandatory, 10–15 minutes)
- Points are deducted for going over or under the time allowed.
- All topics must relate to the equine industry.
- Rosette ribbons will be awarded for each division through 6<sup>th</sup> place. All others will receive a blue, red or white Danish ribbon.
