The Vermont 4-H Working Steer Workshop is designed for 4-H members (ages 8 to 18 as of January 1) to receive expert instruction on the use and care of working steer.

At each station, members will receive expert one-to-one instruction and have an opportunity to work with their animals on the following skills:

- **Ox cart obstacle course station** will give you a chance to hook up to a 2-wheeled ox cart and maneuver through a series of obstacles.
- **Stone boat instructional station** will show you how to work your animals on a chain and on the weight they are pulling.

- Your animals' health papers and approval forms will be checked.
- There will be a potluck lunch — please bring a dish (and your own serving utensil) to share.
