Written materials identifying your club or used to enhance the presentation are suggested, but optional. No points will be awarded towards their use, but points may be deducted for misspelling or not being able to be seen from a distance. Each stage performance must be at least 3 minutes in length but not to exceed 10 minutes. Participants must bring their own CD/tape player. Adults may not accompany youth on stage. Below you will find an evaluator’s opinion as to how effective your presentation is. Read their comments to see what they think would improve your presentation. **Thank you for exhibiting your work!**

** The number of participants at the regional level may not increase if a stage performance is selected to go on to State Day, as well as from State Day to Eastern States.
