How much do CDCI CARES Team services cost?

4 hours of regular services at no cost. After 4 hours, regular services are \$140/hr.

Specialized psycho-educational or speech and language services are \$175/hr.

Our consulting services include:

- In-service training
- Hearing Assistive Technology (HAT) troubleshooting/ Equipment support
- Accommodations Recommendations
- Team meetings
- Transition meeting consultation
- Self-advocacy skill development

We collaborate with school teams, students and their families by remote and in-person consultation services.



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
