



What is the I-Team Early Intervention Project?	We are an interdisciplinary team of Developmental Educator, Speech and Language Pathologist, Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist, and Family Resources Consultant, who provide technical assistance (consultation) and training to local team working with infants and toddlers with complex medical and developmental needs.
What kind of support can the I-Team EI Project provide?	We provide consultative training and support to local teams in the areas of feeding, selecting and obtaining adaptive equipment, enhancing play and relationships, supporting communication, fostering collaborative teaming practices, and promoting community participation.
How will the I-Team EI Project gather information about my child?	We gather information about your child by facilitating a conversation, during which we learn about skills and needs within the context of daily routines and activities. We seek input from all team members in order to gain a well-rounded understanding of your child and to establish team priorities.
How will we know what the I-Team EI Project is going to do with our team?	Once priorities are identified during the intake meeting, the I-Team EI Project team and local team will: 1) develop outcomes identifying objective measures for team support 2) develop an action plan outlining the ways in which I-Team EI support will be provided.
What strategies will the I-Team EI Project use within their consultation?	We provide modeling, coaching, brainstorming, and problem solving within our consultative model. Based on team identified priorities, we provide research-based resources, conduct team-based trainings, and collaborate with local providers.
In what ways does the I-Team EI Project provide support?	We collaborate with local providers using email, in-person consultation, phone, and distance technology. Following all technical assistance visits a summary outlining recommendations and discussion will be provided to the full team.
