

Vermont has seen a steady increase in people working who are receiving services.

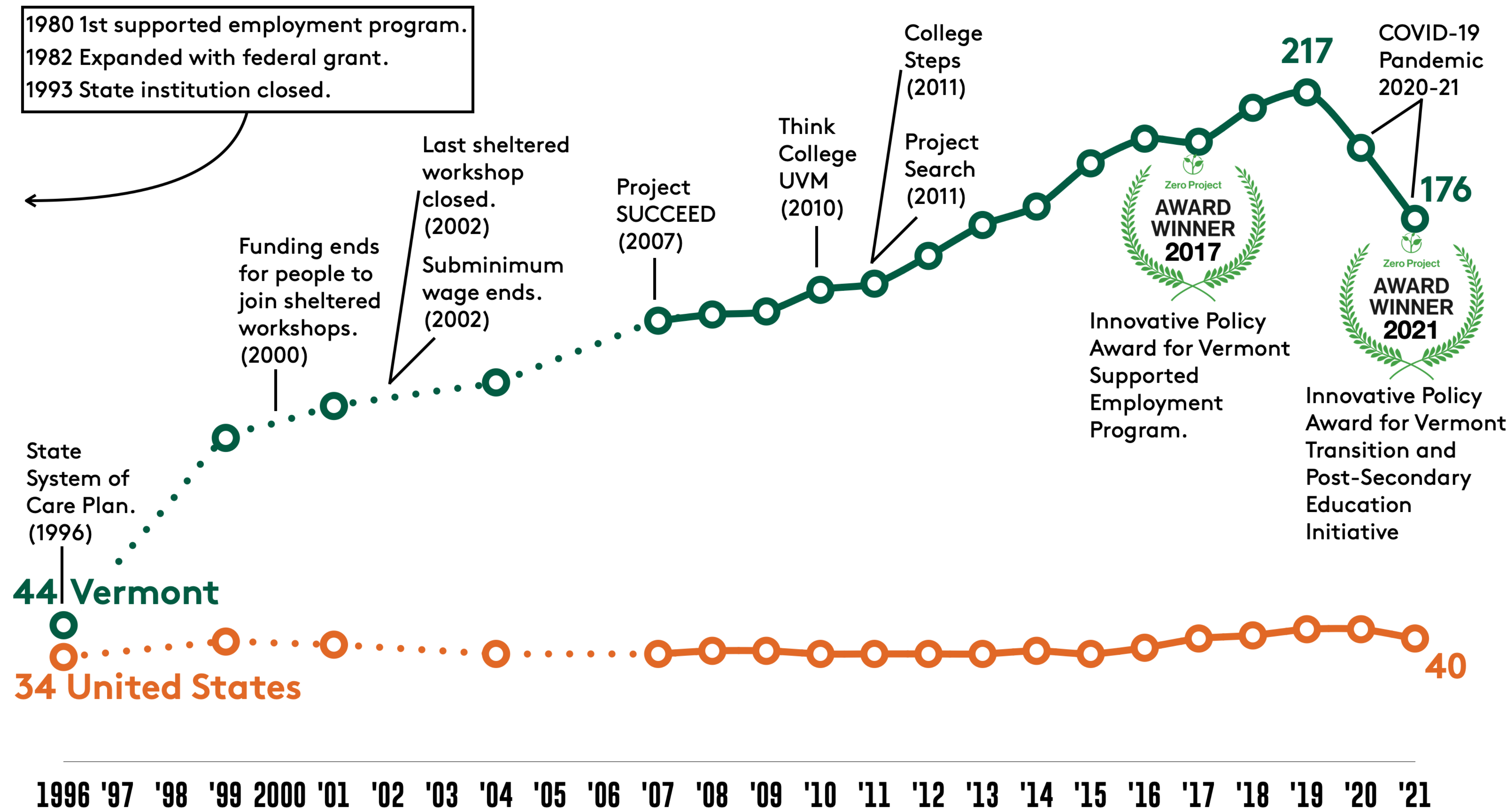
